- 7. Whereas, Students are expected to agree to the proprietary licensure attached to this software;

- 9. Whereas, Access to the licensure in question is often difficult, or hidden from the student
- 10. prior to implied agreement; and
- 11. Whereas, Students are forced to use proprietary software and services with terms they may
- 12. not wish not agree to; and
- 13. Whereas, We believe that every student has the right to understand the terms they agree to
- 14. when they choose to use software; and
- 15. Therefore, let it be resolved that students should be provided with licensure information
- 16. needed to accept the terms of use for required software prior to enrollment; and
- 17. Therefore let it be further resolved, that the Undergraduate Student Government of
- 18. Bowling Green State University requests that the Office of Information Technology Services
- 19. create and maintain an accessible web page that allows a student to view the license terms of
- 20. any required proprietary software prior to enrollment.
