

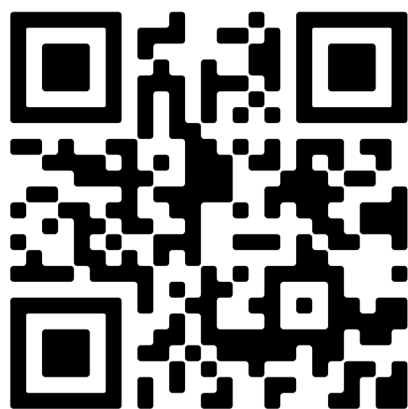

Over **100 billion** new garments are made every year.

One new item of clothing takes **77 gallons** of water to make.

1 in 2 people throw their old clothes straight into the trash. **73%** of apparel is sent to the landfill or incinerated. **95%** of which can be reused or recycled.



By buying **1 used item** you are reducing its carbon, waste, and water footprints by **82%**.
