A Resolution that formally supports the promotion of “Ay Ziggy Zoomba” to the status of an official fight song of Bowling Green State University.

In the senate of the Undergraduate Student Body here assembled,

1. **Whereas**, the Undergraduate Student Government represents the undergraduate student voice at
2. Bowling Green State University; and

3. **Whereas**, the Undergraduate Student Government is committed to the preservation of the rich cultural
4. history of Bowling Green State University; and

5. **Whereas**, “Ay Ziggy Zoomba” has been engrained in Bowling Green State University campus life
6. from the time it was first performed at a special assembly which was called by then President Frank
7. Prout in 1946, under the direction of Gilbert Fox; and

9. **Whereas**, “Ay Ziggy Zoomba” is frequently performed at athletic events, alumni gatherings, and
10. other congregations at Bowling Green State University, to infuse the crowd with school spirit; and

11. **Whereas**, “Ay Ziggy Zoomba” currently serves as an unofficial fight song of Bowling Green State
12. University; and

13. **Whereas**, the Undergraduate Student Government acknowledges the delicate exchange between the
14. creation of new customs and the integrity of the long standing traditions at Bowling Green State
15. University; and

16. **Whereas**, the current official fight song of Bowling Green State University, “Forward Falcons”, was
17. created in 1949 by Dr. Wayne Bohrnstedt, a music professor at the University, and remains deeply
18. engrained in campus life.

19. **Therefore Let It Be Resolved**, that the Undergraduate Student Government wishes to promote and
20. maintain “Forward Falcons” as the current official fight song of Bowling Green State University; and

21. **Therefore Let It Finally Be Resolved**, that the Undergraduate Student Government formally
22. supports the promotion of “Ay Ziggy Zoomba” to the status of official fight song of Bowling Green
23. State University, to serve alongside the current official fight song, “Forward Falcons”.
