

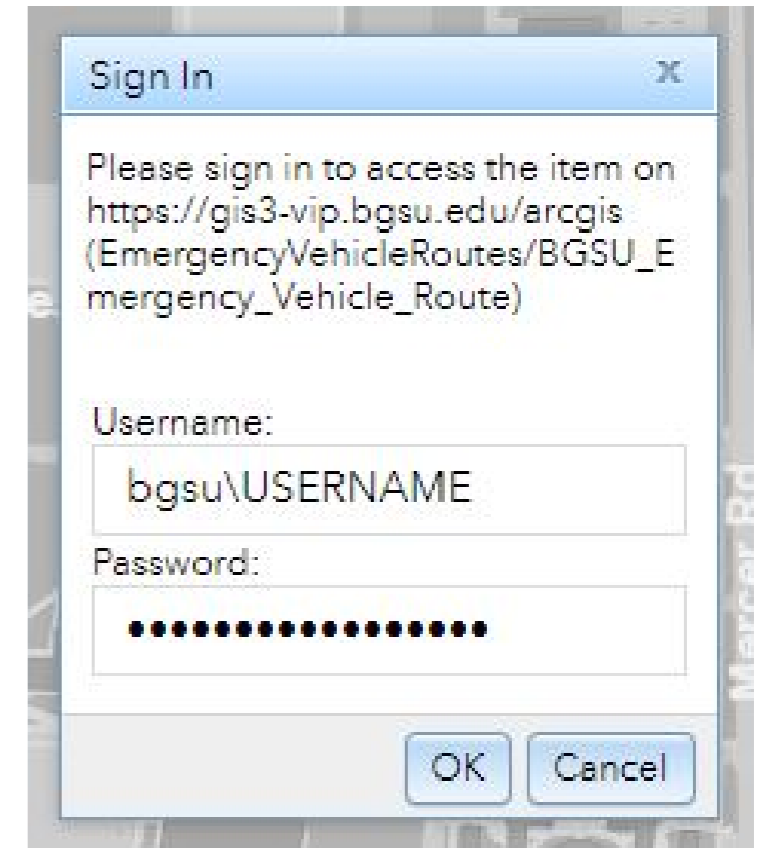
BGSU Campus Features: Web Application Instructions

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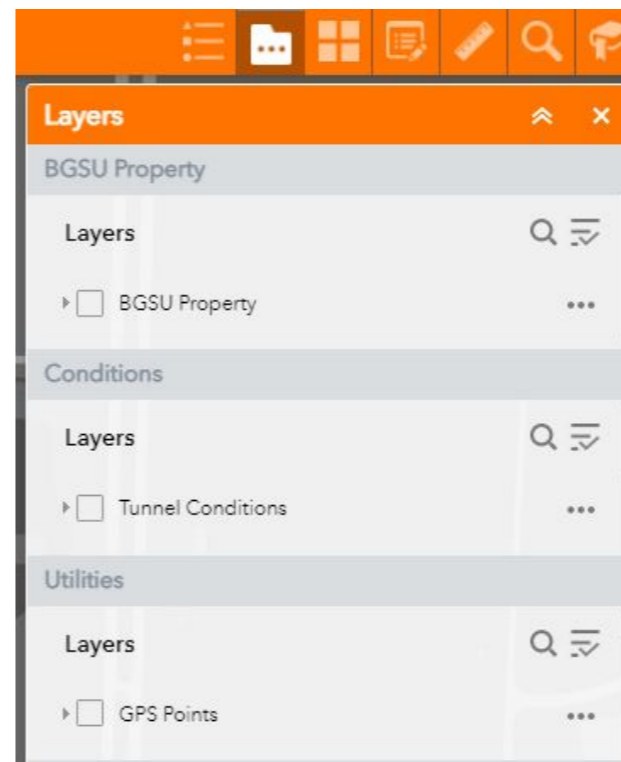
Link & Log-in

- Click [Here](#) to access the Web Application
- *Sign in* screen (as shown below) will prompt for a log-in
 - Username: **bgsu**YOUR BGSU USERNAME
 - Your username is your normal BGSU username, but is preceded by bgsu\ (see image on right. Replace “USERNAME” with your BGSU ID).
 - Password: YOUR BGSU PASSWORD
 - Your password is your current BGSU password.



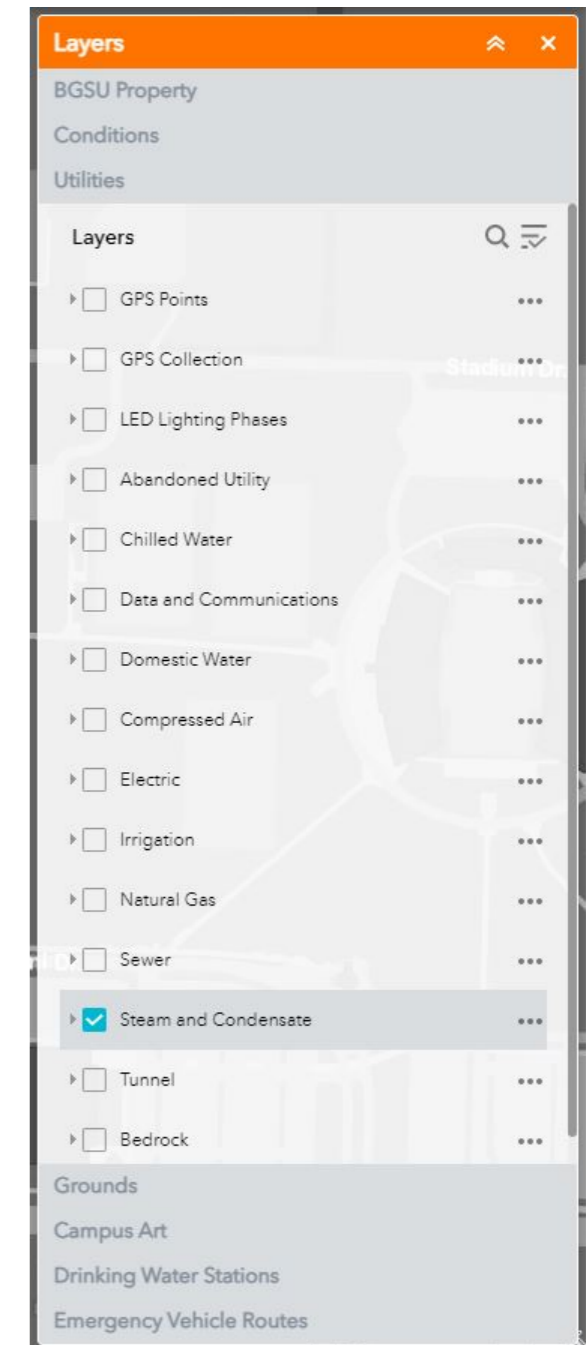
Layers

- The *Group Layer* icon  containing all layers is located in the top right-hand corner of the map
- There are 7 main layer categories:
 - BGSU Property
 - Conditions
 - Utilities
 - Grounds
 - Campus Art
 - Drinking Water Stations
 - Emergency Vehicle Routes

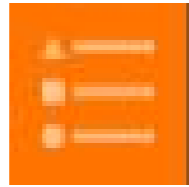


Layers

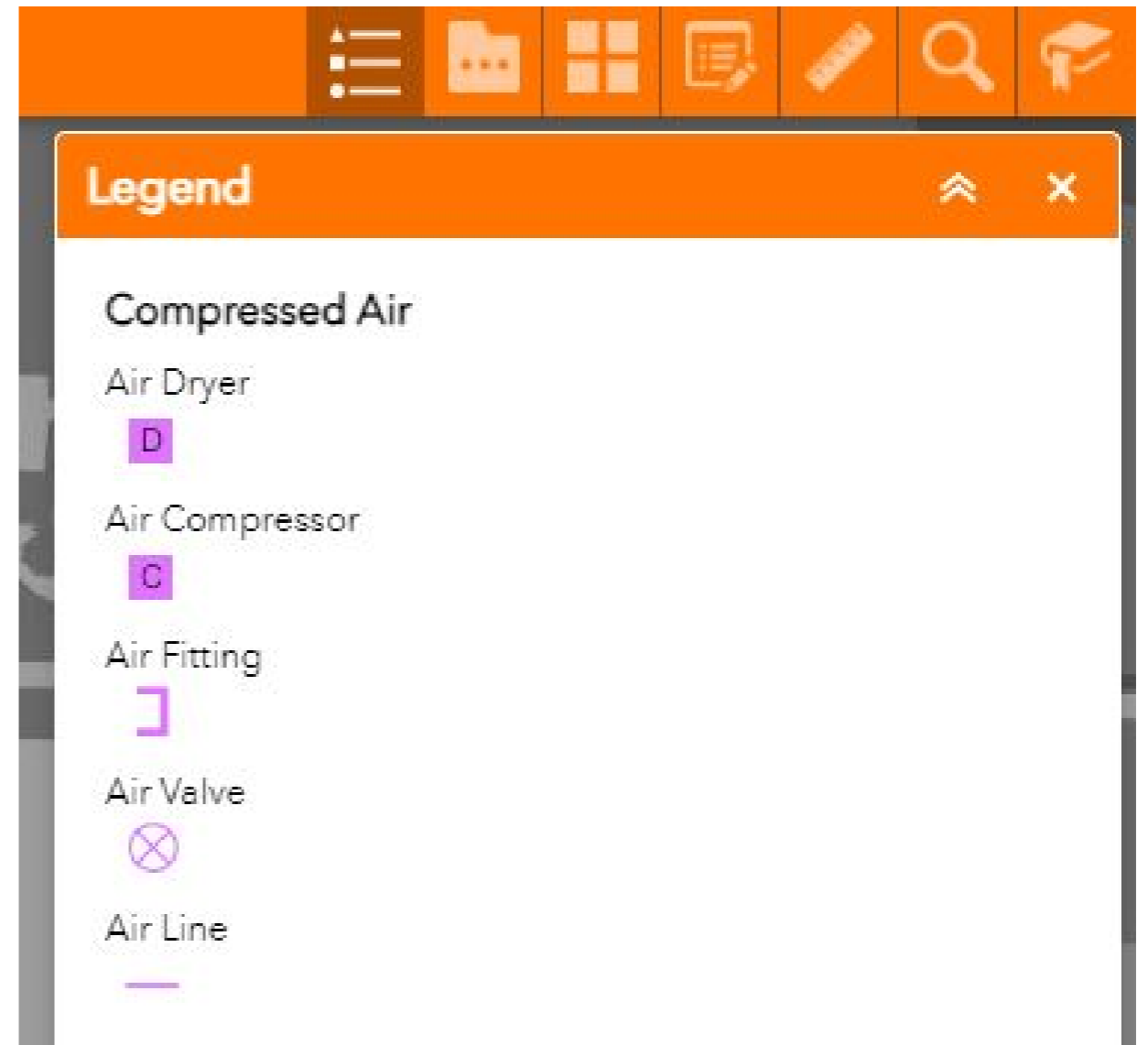
- To expand one group, consolidate all other groups by clicking the grey header bar once.
- Use the scroll bar in each group to view additional layers within a group.
- Turn layers on and off by clicking the box to the left of the layer name.
- Note: Depending on access permissions, some layers will not be visible in the layer list.



Legend










- Located in the top right-hand corner of the map. Shows symbol information for all layers that are on.



Other Icons





- **Home Icon**  – Resets map to default extent
 - Note: All layers presently on will remain on
- **My Location**  – Zooms to current location
 - Note: Pop-up may require user to enable ArcGIS to access your location.
- **Full Screen**  – Expands map frame to fit entire screen
- **Zoom Icon** –
 - + Zoom closer to a feature
 - - Zoom further from a feature
- **Measure**  – Located in the top right-hand corner of the map.
 - **Measurement Types:**
 - Area 
 - Distance 
 - Location 




Other Icons

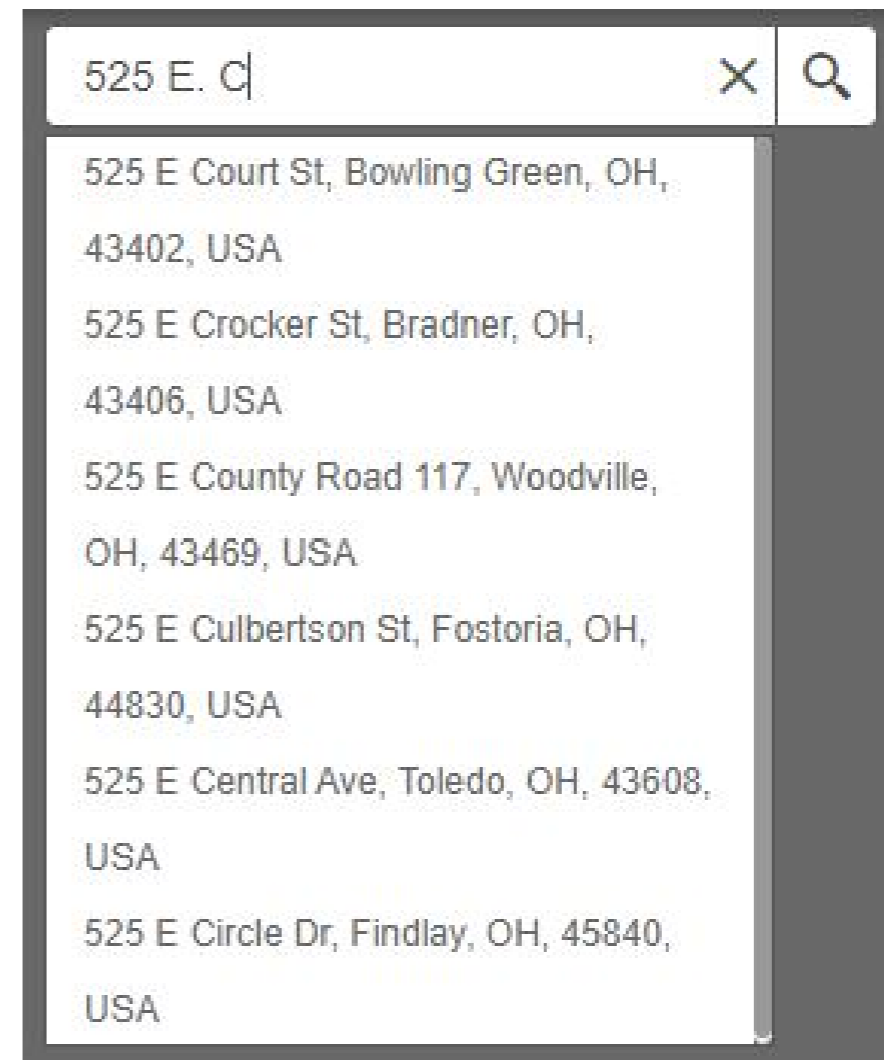


- **Bookmarks**  – Located in the top right-hand corner of the map.
 - **Bookmark Options:**
 - Main Campus
 - Research Park
 - Firelands
 - BGSU at Levis Commons
 - University House
- **Select**  – Located in the top right-hand corner of the map.
 - **To select a feature on the map:**
 - Check the box next to the feature you wish to select
 - Left-click, hold and drag to select desired features
 - Select *Clear* to cancel selection
 - Note: All features wholly or partially within the selection boundary will be selected.



Search Tool

- **Address Search Tool**  – Located in the top left-hand corner of the map. Input an exact address, select from populated drop-down or click *Search* to pan to address




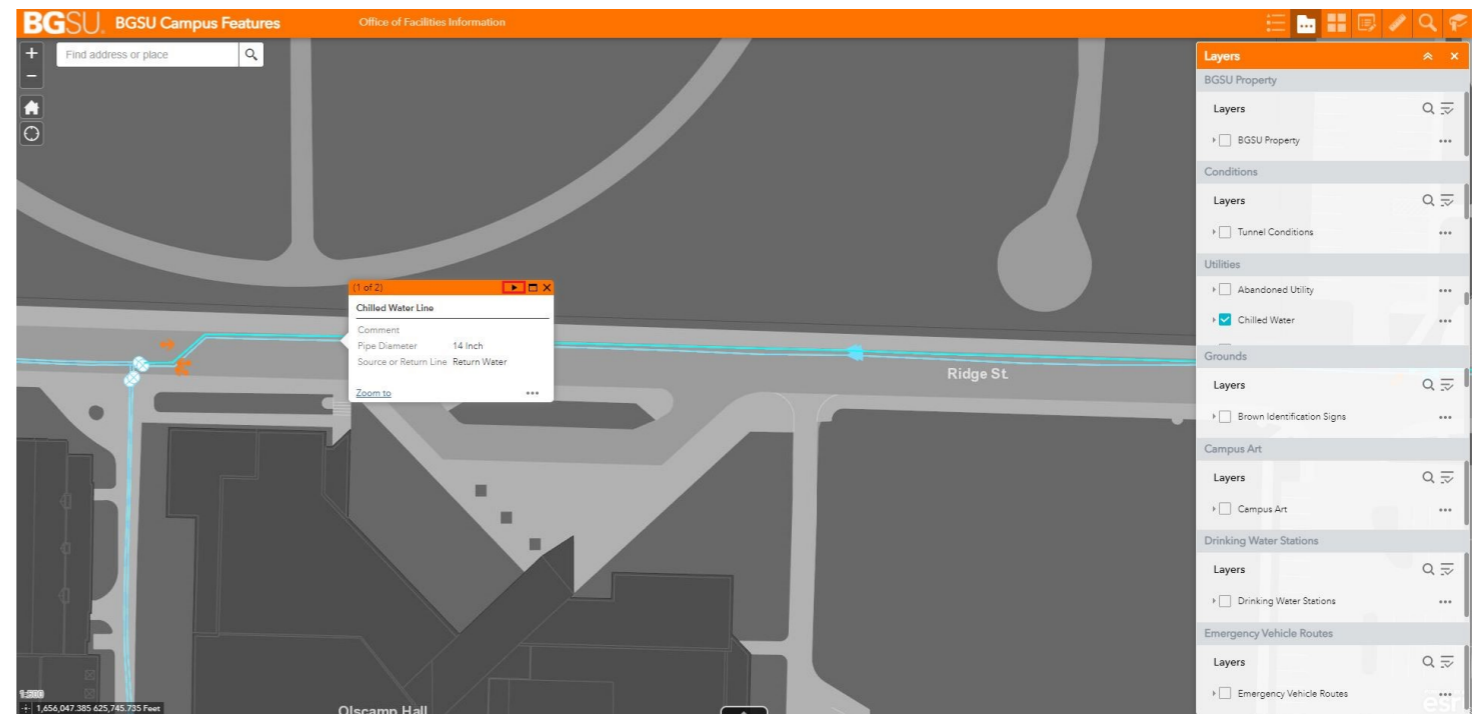
Basemap

- **Basemap** – Located in the top right-hand corner of the map.
- The available BGSU basemaps include:
 - Aerial 2021
 - Darkbasemap 2020



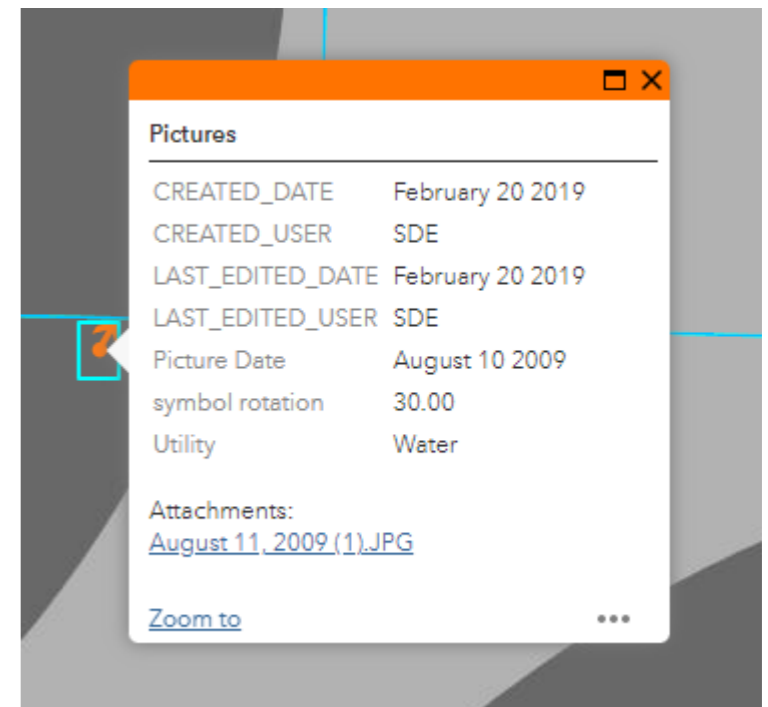
Pop-Ups

- Single click any feature to view feature attributes (image below)
 - To switch selected feature when features are clustered together, click the arrows in the top right-hand corner of the pop-up (highlighted in red in the image below)
- **Zoom to** – Click *Zoom to* in the bottom left-hand corner of a pop-up to zoom into and center map image on the selected feature
- **Dock**  – Click to expand the pop-up



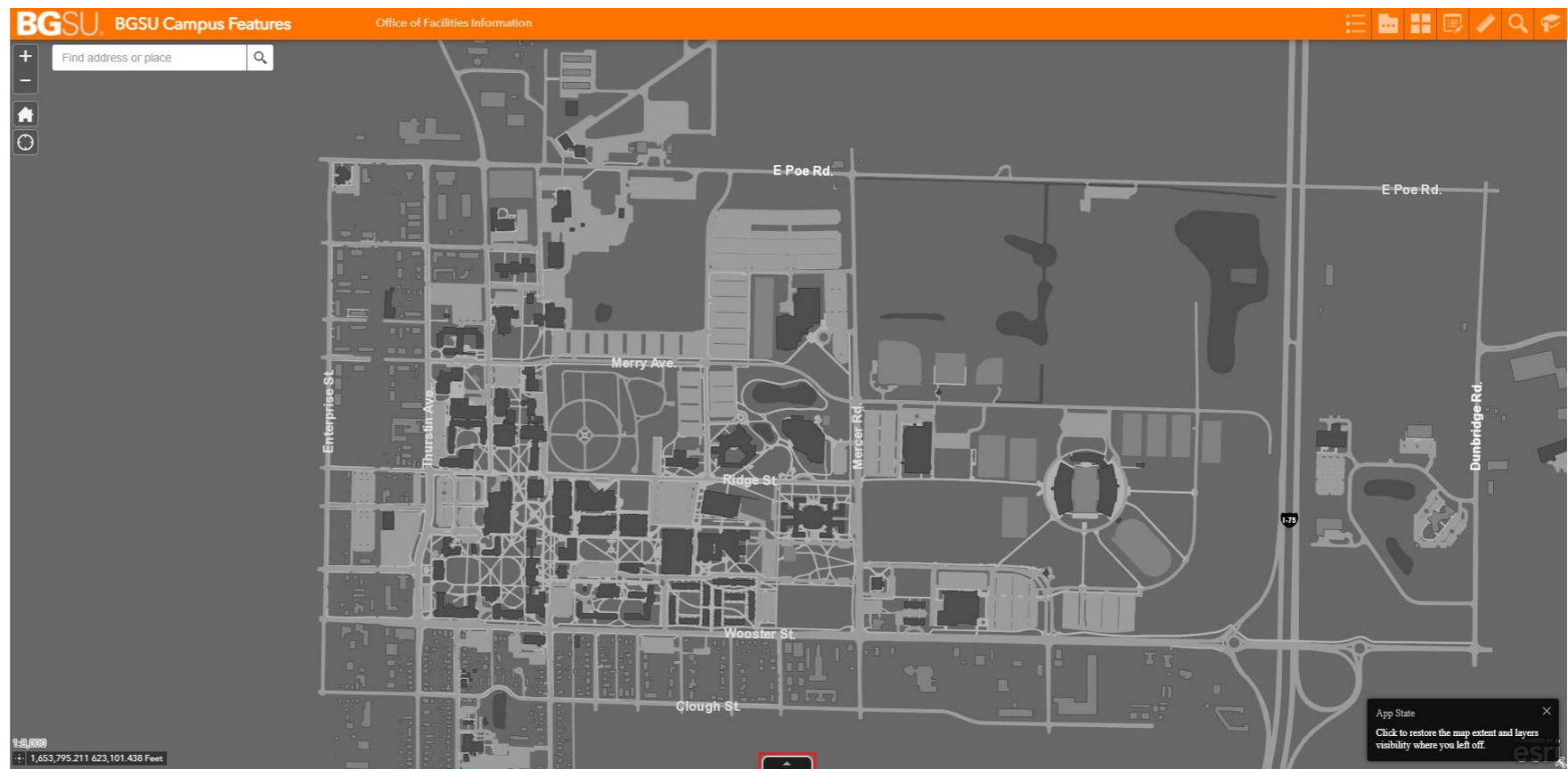
Pop-Ups

- **Attachments** – Some features may have attachments, such as images or documents listed at the bottom of the pop-up.
- **Other tools** ...
 - Pan to: Shifts view to center on selected feature
 - Add marker: Adds new point with coordinates
 - View in Attribute Table: To view feature in attribute table



Attribute Table

- Click the collapsed button with the arrow pointing up at the bottom of the map to open the attribute table for the map features (highlighted red in the image below).

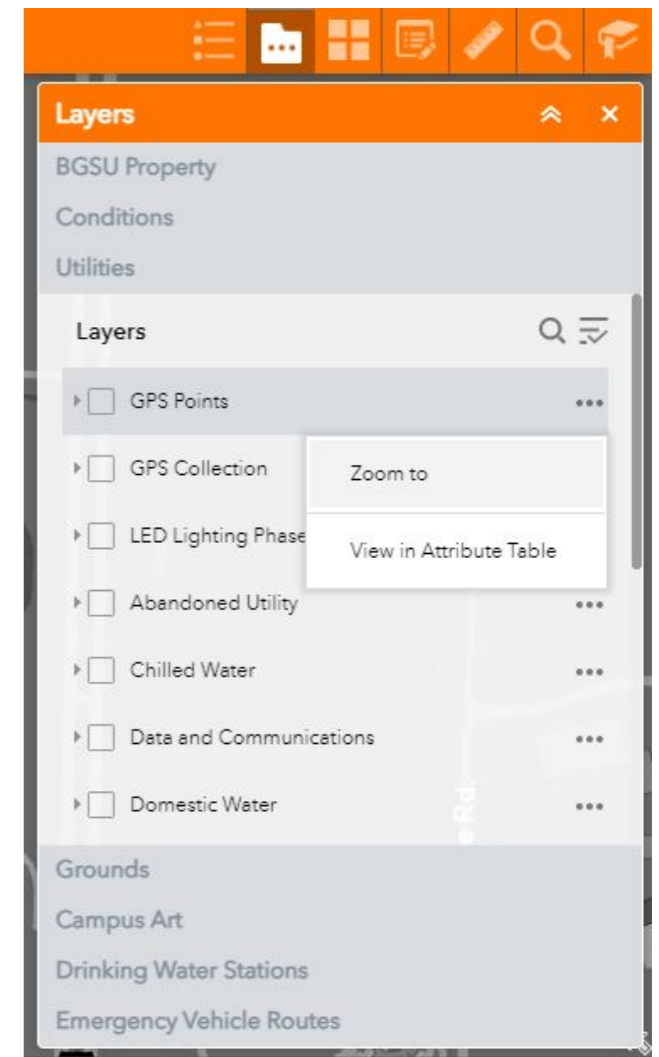


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Attribute Table

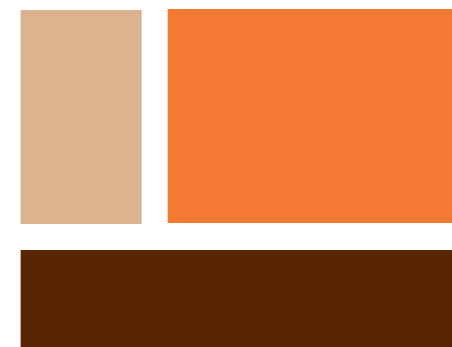
- Open an attribute table by selecting the ellipsis to the right of the desired layer name in the layers list, then select *View in Attribute Table*.
- To further expand the attribute table, hover the mouse between the attribute table and the map. Click, hold and drag the table when the *drag view* icon appears.



Attribute Table Tools



- **Options:**
 - **Show all/selected records:** Only available if there are selected features on the map.
 - **Show related records:** Not available
 - **Filter:** Allows advanced filtering of layers
 - **Show/Hide columns:** Select and deselect fields to view in the attribute table
 - **Export all/selected to CSV:** Will export all features (if no features are selected) or only selected features to CSV file format.
- **Filter by map extent**
 - Click to view only features in the attribute table that are actively shown in the map frame.



Attribute Table Tools



- **Zoom to:** Zooms to selected features
- **Clear selection:** Unselects selected features
- **Refresh:** Updates table when edits are made
- Each field within an attribute table can be sorted in ascending or descending order.



Header



- Click the *Office of Facilities Information* text within the experience header to be directed to the Office of Facilities Information main webpage.
