Graduate Non-Degree Application Instructions

Graduate Non-Degree Student

A student who has earned a four-year degree in higher education and who wishes to enroll in graduate or undergraduate courses without pursuing another degree may enroll as a Graduate Non-Degree Student. Such a st udent is not limited to t he number of gra duate or u ndergraduate courses which may be taken at the University. However, for students enrolling in graduate classes, only **nine** graduate hours will transfer to a graduate degree program. There is no application fee when applying as a Graduate Non-Degree Student.

In most instances Graduate Non-Degree students are NOT eligible for federal financial aid. For example, students taking classes in order to raise their GPA in order to be admitted into a graduate program are not eligible for federal stu dent loans. Students who are taking courses while waiting to be admitted into a graduate program or if the school is waiting for your GRE test scores are also not eligible for federal student loans.

Teacher Certification/Licensure Coursework

A student cannot receive federal financial aid for optional courses the student elects to take for professional recognition or advancement. This includes taking courses for advanced educator licensure or endorsements, or for initial courses recommended by the school but not required for certification/licensure or renewal/re-licensure.

A student may receive Fe deral Direct L oans if e nrolled (at least six credit hours) in a require d teacher certification/licensure program. To qualify, the program must be required for initial PK-12 teacher certification/licensure or renewal/re-licensure in the State of Ohio.

Financial Responsibility

As a st udent enrolled in classes at Bowling Green State University, I agree to assume full financial responsibility for all charges incurred on my student account whether I attend the classes or not.
