

Joseph Black Memorial Scholarship

The Joseph Black Memorial Scholarship will be applied to tuition and instructional fees on your Bursar account. It is awarded annually to a Telecommunications Major. You must meet the following criteria to qualify for this award:

- ✍ Excellence in on-air broadcasting
- ✍ Accumulate 60-105 semester hours by the end of Spring Semester, 2007
- ✍ 3.0 or above grade point average

Scholarship applicants must present evidence of their ability in one of the following forms:

- ✍ Audio or video tape of on-air work
- ✍ A portfolio presentation of radio or television work
- ✍ A contribution in some aspect of broadcasting that leads to on-air performance

First preference will be given to those from Cuyahoga County. The award may be given to another candidate as selected by the University Scholarship Committee, if no student qualifies from Cuyahoga County.

Deadline for return of applications and evidence of ability is 5:00 pm.

Winner of this scholarship will be announced at the Telecommunications Awards Ceremony on March 30, 2007. Scholarship applicants are strongly urged to attend.
