EXAMPLES (in the listing below, we provide recommendations for courses, but the selection of courses must be approved by the advisor and is subject to the availability of the courses). Other programs may be designed with the approval of the advisor. In addition to ECON 302 and 303:

Public Policy

Two of ECON 431, 454, or 462; POLS 110 and 303 and one of POLS 331, 336, 420, or 423

Financial Economics

ECON 402, 311, FIN 330 and FIN 350 and one of FIN 340, 435, or 445

Economic Forecasting

ECON 402 and one of ECON 311, 414, or 452 and STAT 402, 408, and GEOG 312

Market Forecasting

ECON 304, 402 and STAT 402, and GEOG 312, and one of MKT 302 or 320

Global Studies

ECON 351, 454 and POLS 476 and GEOG 225 and one of LEGS 406 or FIN 410 or MKT 455 or BA 439

Politics and Political Economy

ECON 473 and 431 and three of POLS 402, 403, 404, PHIL 312 or 224
