

## Q Classes Spring 2009

Here are some general guidelines for adding your Q classes to the schedule for the system.

1. These courses will be identified by a letter in the section. Most section numbers are M 001, M 022, etc.
  - a. For values class sections, identify these by using a "Q" after the M. You may recall that the M has to stay. It stands for Main Campus. For example

HIST 205 M Q01

It is probably best to do these AFTER your regular sections. This way, the sections will be different from regular sections in two ways: by a AND a unique number. The list might appear:

HIST 205 M 001

HIST 205 M 002

HIST 205 M 003

HIST 205 M Q04

2. These sections are usually opened for general registration like all other sections.
