

Bowling Green State University and its School of Educational Leadership and Policy Studies is seeking applicants for an Instructor (one-year appointment) in the area of Classroom Assessment, Research Methods, and Applied Statistics in Education. Candidates must have completed a doctorate and have a strong quantitative background. A degree in one of the following applied content area(s) is preferred: classroom assessment, statistics and research methods in education, and/or program evaluation in education. Candidates must show evidence of potential for effective teaching, must have expertise in program evaluation, and must be proficient in the use of statistical analysis software (e.g., SPSS, SAS). Position has two primary responsibilities: 1) teaching, and 2) assessment activities related to NCATE. Teaching responsibilities include the following: providing instruction in applied statistics and research methods in education to Master's and doctoral level students in degree programs across the College and University; providing instruction in the area of classroom assessment and evaluation to undergraduate pre-service teachers. NCATE responsibilities include: serving as a consultant for assessment and program evaluation initiatives within the College; planning for and managing *BGSU Professional Education Unit* on-going evaluation for purposes of self study and National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) review. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience. Review of applications will begin June 9, 2008 and will continue until position is filled.
