Position Title: One year temporary position as visiting assistant professor or instructor, Physical Education Teacher Education.

Primary Function:

Teaching and service in undergraduate Physical Education Teacher Education and graduate (Masters level) Developmental Kinesiology.

Specific Responsibilities:
