

Bowling Green State University Graduate Assistant Opportunities

Business Education at Bowling Green State University announces the availability of graduate assistantships for the 2007-2008 academic year for students who wish to complete a Master's Degree. Graduate assistants will receive the following benefits:

- Fee waiver for two semesters and one or two summer sessions
- Stipend of approximately \$8,100 for full time assistantship (this amount may slightly increase before the academic year begins)
- Parking privileges at no cost
- Discount for university purchases including books and supplies

The opportunity to serve as a graduate assistant while earning a Master's Degree will provide students with the opportunity to develop teaching and administrative skills while learning the latest concepts in business and/or marketing education and related areas. The degree can be achieved by completing 33 semester hours of credit during one calendar year.

Six areas of study from which to choose include:

Teacher Licensure in Integrated Business and/or Marketing Education.	Gain a provisional license to teach business and/or marketing in grades 4 - 12 and beyond.
Master Teacher in Business Education	Enhance professional competence in teaching business courses at the secondary, business college, technical/community college and adult education levels.
Master Teacher in Marketing Education	Enhance professional competence in teaching marketing, management, or entrepreneurship at the secondary, business college, technical/community college, and adult education levels.
Postsecondary Education	Prepare to teach business subjects at the postsecondary level (technical schools, community colleges, junior colleges, four-year colleges/universities, and adult and continuing education).
Training and Development	Learn procedures for planning, developing, and implementing training programs in business and industry.
