Paula Holcomb became director of bands at the State University of New York at Fredonia in 1999 after being director of bands for 20 years at Central College in Iowa. At SUNY Fredonia, she oversees an extensive band program consisting of four concert bands while she conducts the Wind Ensemble and musicals. In addition, she initiated the master's in conducting degree program and teaches graduate and undergraduate conducting. Highly sought after as an adjudicator and guest conductor, Holcomb has conducted bands and orchestras in 39 states, South America, Australia, Mexico, Europe and Canada. She has presented conducting symposiums in Canada, South America, Australia and the United States.

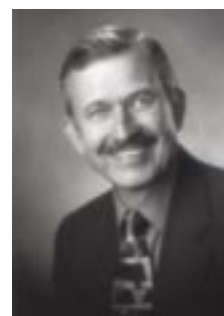
