Position Title Instructor of Jazz Studies. One-year only.

Major Responsibilities The responsibilities of this position will include teaching undergraduate and graduate jazz majors, recruitment of undergraduate and graduate students and contributing to the artistic and intellectual environment of the college and University. Primary teaching duties will include directing a jazz lab band and teaching jazz composition. Additional courses may include jazz pedagogy, applied jazz lessons and coaching jazz combos. Other duties may be assigned by the chair and/or dean.

- Master's degree, doctorate preferred
- Demonstrated successful teaching experience at the college level, as well as significant experience as a versatile jazz performer
- Preference will be given to performers in saxophone, trumpet, trombone or piano

Salary The salary is competitive and commensurate with peer institution levels for rank and position, and in keeping with candidate experience and credentials.
