Latent Growth Curve Model (LGCM) is an advanced statistical technique that allows researchers to describe how individuals change over time and examine what factors may be associated with these changes. This workshop provides an introduction to why social scientists need LGCM, its strengths and weaknesses, what basic LGCM models are, and how to use SAS and Stata to run LGCM models.
