The Minneapolis Population Center has announced the availability of new IPUMS-USA and CPS data.

- The [1940 100% population dataset](#) is available to researchers via the [IPUMS](#). IPUMS-USA currently includes census and ACS microdata samples from 1850-2013 and complete count microdata for 1880 and 1940
- IPUMS-CPS now contains [monthly data from 1989-2013](#) and [ASEC data from 1962-2014](#). A new variable for linking CPS observations over time, [CPSID](#), is also available.
