Adolescent Academic Achievement Study (AACS) Conference – Wednesday, June 10, 9:00 – 4:30, 201 BTSU

The AACS conference will report on findings from this four year longitudinal study conducted with over 1,000 adolescents in Fremont, Ohio. The day's events will report on the significance of school contextual variables (climate and attitude), youth self-perception, and family academic support in relation to achievement. Real world application to middle and high school intervention strategies will be discussed with Fremont and BGSU faculty.
