NCES Releases Restricted-use Data for the Third-Grade Rounds of Data Collection

The Early Childhood Longitudinal Study, Kindergarten Class of 2010-11 (ECLS-K:2011) is a longitudinal study following a nationally representative sample of students from their kindergarten year to the spring of 2016, when most of the students were in fifth grade. This data file (NCES 2016-080) includes information collected during the spring of the 2013-14 school year, when most of the students were in third grade. These data currently are only available in restricted-use format to researchers who apply for and are granted a restricted-use license to use them. A public-use version of the third-grade data will be released with the public-use version of the fourth-grade data in the fall of 2017.
