In order to align with the language in the Department of Health and Human Services regulations for the protection of human subjects in research studies and to reduce confusion, the name of the HSRB has been changed to **Institutional Review Board (IRB)**. The IRB forms and website have been updated accordingly. In addition, the Office of Research Compliance email address has been changed from 'hsrb@bgsu.edu' to 'orc@bgsu.edu' reflecting not only the change in committee name but that the ORC administers multiple committees on campus.
