This workshop introduces TraMineR, a program which uses R for mining, describing and visualizing sequences of states or events. Its primary aim is the analysis of biographical longitudinal data in the social sciences, such as data describing careers or family trajectories. Topics include a brief introduction to R, descriptive analysis and visualization, longitudinal data handling, creating typologies of sequences, and advanced clustering.
