

BGSU IS A NATIONAL LEADER IN PARTNERSHIPS

We're developing unique public-private and public-public partnerships and new, relevant and meaningful academic programs to prepare students for success and to help meet the workforce needs of Ohio and beyond.

- A partnership with the Ohio Attorney General and the Bureau of Criminal Investigation continues to provide the foundation for BGSU to be at the forefront in forensic science education in the state of Ohio, offering innovative research, new undergraduate and graduate academic programs.
- BGSU and Cedar Fair, a national attraction and entertainment company, partnered to establish the Cedar Fair Resort and Attraction Management program. This academic program is embedded in a nationally recognized theme park, Cedar Point. Junior and senior classes are taught at a state-of-the-art residential facility near the amusement park in Sandusky, Ohio. The only educational opportunity of its kind in the country, the field of study provides unprecedented leadership and professional opportunities in the fast-growing field.
- BGSU, Owens Community College and the University of Findlay, recently announced a partnership to develop the Center to Advance Manufacturing. This center demonstrates the power of a fouryear public university, a two-year public community college and a private four-year university all coming together to partner and to demonstrate our relevance to Ohio and beyond. It is just one example of how BGSU is meeting workforce demands by connecting education and listening and responding to industry needs.
- BGSU and the Wood County Health Department announced an innovative public-public partnership to improve the public health of Wood County and northwest Ohio through health instruction, practice, research and workforce development.

GROUNDBREAKING RELEVANT RESEARCH

The research and creative activities of our faculty inform public debate and address significant issues facing our society.

- Researchers with the Great Lakes Center for Fresh Waters and Human Health are doing critical research to address issues in our own backyard – the toxic algal blooms that plague Lake Erie and impact freshwater sources around the world.
- Faculty with the Center for Photochemical Sciences are studying
 the uses of light-responsive chemical compounds for beneficial
 applications in health, industry, agriculture and other fields. Our
 research includes work to develop degradable polymers that could
 become an alternative for plastic, which could change the world.
- Faculty in the Department of Sociology and its National Center for Marriage and Family Research are contributing to the understanding of evolving social patterns and how family structure in the United States is linked to the health and well-being of children, adults, families and communities. Their findings are helping to guide public policy and program decisions.
- Researchers affiliated with the Center for the Future of Forensic
 Science made a lifesaving discovery in response to the national
 opioid epidemic. They scientifically proved that the laundry detergent
 OXICLEAN™ will deactivate Fentanyl. That research finding is helping
 law enforcement and other first responders prevent accidental
 exposure to the deadly drug.
- Longtime BGSU researcher Dr. Peggy Giordano was the 2022 corecipient of the Stockholm Prize in Criminology, awarded by Queen Silvia of Sweden, the top international prize in criminology. The honor comes as a result of Giordano's career-long work researching crime, in particular examining why people commit crimes and how they might break the pattern of criminal involvement.



PAYING IT FORWARD AND MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Our students, faculty and staff make a difference in their communities. Our innovative academic programs and national rankings showcase the University's impact.

- BGSU is ranked the No. 1 university in Ohio public or private for student experience by The Wall Street Journal.
- For the fourth year in a row, The Wall Street Journal has named BGSU the No. 1 public university in the Midwest students would choose again. The Wall Street Journal also named BGSU America's No. 3 public university for teaching quality.
- BGSU continues to be ranked as a tier-one public university by U.S. News & World Report.
- In 2021, Forbes ranked BGSU as the No. 3 midsize employer in the United States. This ranking showcases our high-quality and committed faculty and staff.
- As a public university for the public good, the Division of Research and the Center for Regional Development developed the Reimagining Rural Regions Initiative to provide expertise and capacity to assist communities to undertake a placemaking process to identify assets that could be reimagined in an effort to improve quality of life and to aid in the retention and attraction of talent.
- BGSU is recognized with the Community Engagement Classification from the Carnegie Foundation for its leadership in service-learning initiatives and partnerships.

PROGRAM NOTES

Today's Commencement ceremony marks the 309th graduation at Bowling Green State University. The total number of diplomas being awarded is 2,548, including 544 degrees granted by the Graduate College. Undergraduate degrees are awarded with Latin honors to signify meritorious academic achievement; 1,071 students are receiving honors. Students with honors wear a gold cord designating their status.

To graduate cum laude, a student must have a cumulative grade-point average of at least 3.50 and 60 letter-graded hours or more. Magna cum laude requires a 3.75 grade-point average, while summa cum laude demands a 3.9 grade-point average.

This program contains the names of all candidates for this Commencement. Certification of the indicated degree is subject to the completion of requirements.

SCHOOL COLORS

The History behind how BGSU began using brown and orange as its school colors dates back to 1914. Dr. Homer B. Williams, the University's first president, gathered a group of people, including Dr. Leon L. Winslow, from the industrial Arts department, as a selection committee for the school's new colors. While on a trolley ride to Toledo, Dr. Winslow sat behind a woman wearing a large hat adorned with brown and orange feathers. He was so impressed by the color scheme that his committee recommended to the Board of Trustees they approve the combination of burnt orange and seal brown. Today, BGSU is the only Division I university to have orange and brown as its school colors.

UNIVERSITY MACE

The mace, used as a weapon in medieval times, is employed today on many university campuses as a symbol of office. The mace of the President of Bowling Green State University bears symbols and figures representing three related categories of human culture: areas of learning, the vicissitudes of culture, and the waxing and waning of human life. Designed and created by Harold Hasselschwert, an assistant professor of Art, the mace weighs six and one-half pounds and is 27 inches long. The mace is engraved and enameled silver, creating a moiré effect as a backdrop for figures representing the six branches of learning: drama, Art, literature, music, science and commerce. Approximately 500 square inches of silver were used in the mace, which is adorned with ancient and medieval symbols. At the base are engravings representing the areas of learning: jester's staff, quill and scroll, lyre, palette and brushes, the atom and the balance.

THE PENDANT

A silver pendant containing the inaugural symbol and University seal is worn by the President of Bowling Green State University on ceremonial occasions. The medallion was created in 1964 by Dr. Carl D. Hall, BGSU professor. It depicts a "tree of knowledge" and symbolizes the University's growth at that time.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Academic regalia originated in medieval European universities during the 14th century when commencement ceremonies were associated with religious ordination. Universities in Europe and the United States continue the tradition of wearing special robes, caps and hoods for formal academic occasions.

THE GOWN

The typical academic gown is black. Bachelor's and master's degree gowns are plain, although sometimes worn with honor cords or medallions. The doctoral gown is trimmed down the front and around the sleeves with bands of velvet, either in black or a color associated with the graduate's field of study. Sleeve styles also vary with the degree: pointed sleeves on the bachelor's degree gown, oblong sleeves for the master's degree and round, full sleeves for the doctoral robe.

THE HOOD

Graduates holding master's or doctoral degrees typically wear a hood that fits around the neck and drapes down the back of the robe. The hood lining displays colors associated with particular schools. Chevrons in a second color indicate a dual emphasis, while velvet edging on the hood corresponds to the graduate's field of study. The doctoral hood is longer than the master's degree hood, and trimmed with additional velvet panels.

THF CAP

The standard cap worn with academic regalia is the mortar board, usually the same color as the gown. Bachelor's degree candidates at Bowling Green State University wear colored tassels to represent their academic areas.



Posthumous Honorary Degree **RECIPIENT**

James Boro Karugu '62, Former Attorney General of Kenya



James Boro Karugu (1937-2022) was born while Kenya was under British colonial rule. He started his education at St. Peter Claver's Primary School for Africans on Racecourse Road in Nairobi City. The school was run by the Catholic Church, and education then was racially segregated.

The seeds of Karugu's journey to a distinguished public law service career were planted while he was at St. Peter Claver's and his father lost a colonial Kenya High Court case. Young Karugu watched in awe from the court's public gallery as the plaintiff's and defendant's lawyers sought to persuade the court to rule in their favor. When his father lost, Karugu immediately resolved to study law and avenge his father's loss. He did eventually get his sweet revenge in court against the lawyer who made his father eat the bitter herbs of defeat!

After St. Peter Claver's, Karugu joined Mangu High School near Thika, Kenya. The school was then known as Holy Ghost College Mangu and also run by the Catholic Church. The school had a strict code of ethics, discipline and character development that students followed. This code was to serve Karugu well in his professional life. At Mangu, Karugu also joined the drama club, which gave him an opportunity to sharpen his intellectual, debate and oratory skills, and to grow

his self-confidence – all of which later contributed to his public service success. After Mangu, Karugu worked for a while for The Standard Vacuum Oil Company in Nairobi. He held on to his dream of avenging his father's court loss, though the dream looked impossible given his family's meager means. If he was to achieve his dream, he had to find his own way.

Besides its legendary academic and discipline regimen, Mangu also had a distinctive school uniform that helped to connect Karugu with Mr. Mark Kaigwa, a one-time deputy mayor of Nairobi who introduced Karugu to Dr. Julius Gikonyo Kiano, the first Kenyan to ever earn a Ph.D. Kiano was to later play a pivotal role in introducing Karugu to Bowling Green State University (BGSU) by way of the American Information Library at the old U.S. Embassy in downtown Nairobi. Ultimately, Karugu secured admission to BGSU. With the financial support of his father, a small BGSU stipend and his own savings, Karugu enrolled at the University in 1958. He graduated with a B.A. in political science in 1962. He was the first Kenyan and African student to ever study at the University.

Karugu's BGSU journey had many highlights, including his election as president of the International Students' Society. In this role, he interacted with many local community groups who reveled in the opportunity to meet an African for the first time. Karugu also babysat future Olympic ice-skating champion Scott Hamilton. He won an athletic scholarship after his African American roommate challenged him to a race across the lush lawns of the Rodgers Quadrangle dormitory. He won the race barefoot by over 20 meters!

From BGSU, Karugu joined Lincoln's Inn in central London, UK. His BGSU education served him well there, leading to the completion of his law degree in 1964 after ust two years of study. He returned to Kenya a few weeks before the country became independent and was appointed crown counsel. When Kenya became independent on Dec. 12, 1964, Karugu became state counsel. He then rose to become senior state counsel and later, deputy public prosecutor in 1971. In 1980, President Daniel Arap Moi appointed him Kenya's second attorney general. He resigned in 1981 and went into private business.

In 2010, Karugu was named one of BGSU's 100 most prominent alumni. Along with other top 100 alumni from around the globe, he returned to the University that year and was recognized for his career accomplishments and for personifying the University's tradition of excellence. By this time, Karugu had retired to his coffee farm in Kiambu near Nairobi, to the very farm where his late wife once picked coffee in her youth! He felt privileged to provide the Kenyan coffee and tea that were served at the University's 2010 centennial gala and award ceremony. Karugu died on Nov. 10, 2022, at 85 years old. He was buried next to his dear late wife, Margaret Waithira Karugu (1938-2007), at their home in Kiamara Estate on Nov. 19, 2022. The couple had four children (Victoria Nyambura, Rose Gathira, Eric Mwaura and Benjamin Githara), to whom they endeavored to teach the importance of a good education and sound time management. Karugu would be very happy to receive this honorary doctorate in public service from his beloved alma mater.

Lieutenant Colonel Ryan J. Nowlin, '00, '04



Director Lt. Col. Ryan J. Nowlin joined "The President's Own" United States Marine Band in August 2010 as staff arranger. He was appointed Assistant Director and commissioned a first lieutenant in July 2014, was promoted to the rank of captain in July 2016, was appointed Executive Officer and Associate Director in May 2018, and earned the rank of Major in January 2020. He was promoted to his current rank in December 2023. On Dec. 20, 2023, during a Change of Command Ceremony officiated by Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps General Christopher J. Mahoney, Lt. Col. Nowlin became the 29th Director of "The President's Own" United States Marine Band.

With "The President's Own," Lt. Col. Nowlin has arranged and composed a variety of music for the Marine Band, Marine Chamber Orchestra, and small ensembles. His arrangements are frequently included in high-profile national events to include a 2013 collaboration with Beyoncé ("The Star-Spangled Banner") and Kelly Clarkson ("America") for the second inauguration of President Barack Obama as well as an arrangement of "The Star-Spangled Banner" for Jordin Sparks in honor of the anthem's 200th anniversary at Fort McHenry (2014.) His setting of "Amazing Grace" is regularly included as part of the annual Marine Corps Worship Service held at the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C. In 2013, Lt. Col. Nowlin's concert march "The Montford Point Marines" honoring the first African Americans to serve in the United States Marine Corps

was premiered for President and Mrs. Obama at the Friday Evening Parade at Marine Barracks Washington. In 2018, he composed the march "Century of Service" in honor of 100 years of women's service in the Corps.

Lt. Col. Nowlin's music has been heard in performance at countless White House events including receptions, state dinners, and Independence Day celebrations on the South Lawn. His wind band transcriptions have been recorded on five Marine Band albums to include "From the Keyboard" (Bach's Toccata and Fugue in D minor); "Picture Studies" (David Conte's A Copland Portrait); "Arioso" (Bach's Fantasia and Fugue in C minor); "A Leonard Bernstein Tribute" (Leonard Bernstein's Scenes from A White House Cantata); and "Monuments" (Jennifer Higdon's blue cathedral.)

Lt. Col. Nowlin has enjoyed conducting the Marine Band and Chamber Orchestra in public performances during their winter/spring concert series and at summer concerts on the National Mall, as well as at ceremonies and national events at the U.S. Capitol, Washington National Cathedral, and at the White House. Additionally, he has conducted the band at Wolf Trap National Park for the Performing Arts in Vienna, Va., at The Midwest Clinic in Chicago, at the 2022 WASBE International Conference in Prague, on the Marine Band's national concert tours, and on the band's international tours to Japan (2019) and Europe (2022).

Lt. Col. Nowlin has served as a producer for nineteen Marine Band albums to include each annual release since 2014, The Complete Marches of John Philip Sousa recording project since its inception, and the album "John Williams and 'The President's Own'". Additionally, he served as a producer for the Emmy award-winning program "New England Triptych" in partnership with the All-Star Orchestra.

Lt. Col. Nowlin is also the unit's Education Officer. A music educator and high school band director before joining "The President's Own," Lt. Col. Nowlin is a dedicated advocate for music education. He currently manages Marine Band educational outreach initiatives such as Music in the Schools, Music in the High Schools, Tour Educational Outreach, and the Concerto Competition for High School Musicians, and has been involved in the Marine Band's Young People's Concerts since 2011.

Lt. Col. Nowlin is a 1996 graduate of North Royalton High School in Ohio. He earned both a Bachelor of Arts in Music Education and his Master of Music in Music Education and Conducting in 2004 from Bowling Green State University in Ohio, where he studied horn with Herbert Spencer, Jr. and conducting with Bruce Moss and Emily Freeman Brown. He has also studied composition with prolific composer Anne McGinty and has participated in workshops and master classes with several renowned conductors and educators including H. Robert Reynolds, Mallory Thompson, Harry Begian, and Frederick Fennell.

In addition to his duties with the United States Marine Band, Lt. Col. Nowlin frequently appears as a guest conductor with high school honor and all-state bands, community and municipal bands, and with university ensembles across the country. His published music and methods are used in lessons and performances around the globe, and he can frequently be found providing clinics and master classes to teachers and students around the country.
