

Students in CDIS may be pre-CDIS (declared pre-major) or be CDIS majors. CDIS major classes (highlighted below in turquoise) can only be enrolled in when you are fully in the major. You can apply during the semester you are enrolled in the final course(s) you need, but will not be able to pre-register for classes until after the end of the semester when grades are in and your application has been reviewed.
