Students in CDIS may be pre-CDIS (declared pre-major) or be CDIS majors. CDIS major classes (highlighted below) can only be enrolled in when you are fully in the major. You can apply during the semester you are enrolled in the final course(s) you need, but will not be able to pre-register for classes until after the end of the semester when grades are in and your application has been reviewed.

- 1. During the pre-major sequence (1230, 2240, 2250) complete one of the offered speech-hearing screenings. Transfer students who took these classes elsewhere should contact the Speech & Hearing Clinic directly (419-372-2515) to schedule a time to complete this.
- 2. During the semester you will complete the final pre-major courses, fill out an application to the major and turn it in to Room 200 Health Center. - 3. **After grades are posted**, your transcript will be checked to see if you met the admissions standards. If so, you will receive a letter confirming that you are accepted into the major, and at that time you may register for classes.
