This program prepares students to meet State and Federal Nursing Home Administrator licensure standards. Enrollment in the Long-Term Care (LTC) specialization program requires maintaining a GPA of 2.50 with a grade of C or better in GERO 1010. All LTC specialization program core courses require a grade of C or higher and an overall GPA of at least 2.50 is required before an internship (practicum) placement can be arranged.


