2.) Describe a recent particularly satisfying public service activity. Do not repeat experience described in question above. Why was this activity satisfying and why did you choose to be involved? What role did you play? How does this service activity connect to/prepare you for your career plans? (The writer of your letter of recommendation re: Public Service must confirm this experience.)
3.) Describe the problem or needs of society you want to address when you enter public service. If possible, use statistical data to define the magnitude of the problem.

4.) What are the three most significant courses you have taken in preparation for your career? Why are these the most significant?
5.) What are your career goals and aspirations? What position(s) do you hope to attain? How will you use your career to effect change? Why this role/path? How do you envision yourself creating change and serving the public?
6.) Describe the graduate education program you intend to pursue. Why this program and this institution? How will this program prepare you for your career goals?

7.) Policy Proposal - The proposal must be related to the problem(s) you identified in the item above. Do not exceed 500 words. You need to identify the office and person to whom you are writing.
