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BACKGROUND AND METHODOLOGY

The BGSU New Student Transition Questionnaire was developed in Fall 1997 as a means of gathering information about how well first year first time students were becoming acclimated to college life within their first six weeks at BGSU. This report describes the results of the eleventh administration of the survey in Fall 2007.

The 2007 survey was administered to all new freshmen at BGSU main campus who enrolled in English 110, 111, and 112H classes in early September. Two thousand two hundred and ninety-nine surveys were returned. This represents 82% of the survey population (2810) and 71% of first time first year new students at BGSU's main campus (3,233). Of the 2,299 respondents, 874 students provided valid PID numbers, which allowed us to identify respondents' gender, ethnicity, college, as well as the first year program in which most of them are participating (see Table 1 and Table 2 below). The survey respondents, in general, mirror the population in terms of gender, race, and college.

The survey results were analyzed by noting the percentages of participants who provided various responses to each questionnaire item. Percentages may not always sum to 100 due to rounding. In addition, group differences were investigated and significant differences are noted where they occurred.

Differences Between Genders:

Female students were more likely than male students to report that "I have taken advantage of mentoring or tutoring groups" and that "I miss home and my friends who are not at BGSU".

Differences Between Race/Ethnic Groups:

European American students were more likely that minority students to report that "I find my classes are challenging", "I have figured out how to study effectively", "I like the social life at BGSU", "I am satisfied with my living accommodations", and "I would recommend BGSU to my friends". Minority students, on the other hand, were more likely than their counterparts to take advantage of mentoring or tutoring groups to improve their academic performance. They were also more likely than European American students to claim that they can not find things to do on weekends and that they were not managing their time well.

Differences Among Colleges:

Among the students in the seven colleges, Academic Enhancement students were most likely to have difficulty deciding on a major or career. Compared with the students in the five other colleges, students in the College of Musical Arts and the College of Technology were more likely to claim that they have been actively involved with their classes; students in the College of Health and Human Services and the College of Musical Arts were more likely to indicate that they were having trouble keeping up with their studies. While students in the College of Education and Human Development were most likely to report that they missed home and their friends who are not at BGSU, students in the College of Technology were least likely to say so. Technology students were also least likely to agree that they were not concerned about alcohol use among students.

Statistically significant differences in responses among students in various first year programs could not be determined due to overlap in program participation. Group differences are instead simply reported where a substantially larger portion of students in one or more programs agreed or disagreed with a given item than did students in other groups (see Table 5 below).

The plus sign (+) indicates that there is a substantially larger portion of students in one or more programs who were **more likely to agree** with a given item than were students in other programs.

The minus sign (-) indicates that there is a substantially larger portion of students in one or more programs who were <u>less</u> **likely to agree** with a given item than were students in other programs.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

Most Fall 2007 new freshmen seem to be becoming academically and socially integrated into college life during their first a few weeks at BGSU. Although 58% of the survey respondents indicated that they missed their home and friends who are not at BGSU, the majority of them did report that it was easy for them to adjust to the University (85%), and that they got along well with others on campus (90%), made new friends easily (77%), and didn't feel lonely, left out, or isolated (80%). Two out of three of them pointed out that they were satisfied with their roommates as well as their living accommodations and were not bothered by the noise level on their residence hall floor. Most of them feel that the faculty and staff members they encountered at BGSU had a good attitude toward students and it's easy for them to get in touch with teachers or staff outside of class. More than seventy percent of them agreed that they can find things to do on weekends and that they liked the social life at BGSU. Eighty-six percent of the survey respondents would recommend BGSU to their friends.

Forty-eight percent of the new freshmen found their classes challenging and yet only 18% of them have taken the advantages of mentoring or tutoring groups. Nearly half or more of them reported that they have figured out how to study effectively and that they were actively involved with their classes. About a quarter or less of them, however, still had trouble or difficulty keeping up with their studies (16%), managing their time (19%), and deciding a major or a career (23%).

The survey results also tend to reveal some substantial differences across student groups. Caution is to be advised in interpreting the results due to the fact that, even though the distribution across groups in the questionnaire sample parallels that of the whole population in terms of gender, race and college, only 874 respondents (27% of the first time, first year freshmen) provided valid PID numbers that allowed for group comparisons to be made. Feedback concerning how this and other studies and how they can continue to be improved is always welcome.
