## REPORT OF THE RESULTS OF THE 2010 NEW STUDENT TRANSITION QUESTIONNAIRE

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#### **BACKGROUND AND METHODOLOGY**

The BGSU New Student Transition Questionnaire was developed in Fall 1997 as a means of gathering information about how well first-year first-time students were becoming acclimated to college life within their first a few weeks at BGSU. This report describes the results of the 13th administration of the survey in Fall 2010.

The 2010 survey was administered to all new freshmen at BGSU main campus who enrolled in English 110, 111, and 112H classes in September. Two thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight surveys were returned. This represents about 88% of the survey population (3,279) and 75% of first-time first-year new students at BGSU's main campus (3,841). Of the 2,868 respondents, 1,646 students provided valid PID numbers, which allowed us to identify respondents' gender, ethnicity, college, as well as the first year program in which most of them are participating (see Table 1 and Table 2 below). The survey respondents, in general, mirror the population in terms of gender, race, and college.

The survey results were analyzed by noting the percentages of participants who provided various responses to each questionnaire item. Percentages may not always sum to 100 due to rounding. In addition, group differences were investigated and significant differences are noted where they occurred.

Compared with the respondents in 2009, 2010 survey respondents were more likely to report that "I find my classes challenging" (46% agreed or somewhat agreed in 2009 vs. 57% in 2010), but less likely to say that "I miss home and my friends who are not at BGSU" (55% in 2009 agreed or somewhat agreed vs. 43% in 2010).

### Among the 2010 respondents,

- Females and minority students were more likely than males and European-American students to claim that their classes are challenging;
- Females and the respondents in the College of Business Administration and the College of Health and Human Services were more likely than males and the students in the five other colleges to point out that they have taken advantage of mentoring or tutoring groups to improve their academic performance;
- Male students were more likely than female students to indicate that "I am making friends easily", "I am not concerned about alcohol use among students, and "the noise level on my floor does not interfere with my ability to sleep or study within my personal room";
- While minority students were less likely than European-American students to agree that "I miss home and my friends who are not at BGSU", they were more likely to <u>disagree</u> that "I have figured out how to study effectively";
- Among the respondents in the seven colleges:
  - Musical Arts students were most likely to say that "I have figured out how to study effectively" and "I am involved with campus activities outside of class";
  - Academic Enhancement students were most likely to feel that they had difficulty to decide a major or career.

Statistically significant differences in responses among students in various first year programs could not be determined due to overlap in program participation. Group differences are instead simply reported where a substantially larger portion of students in one or more programs agreed or disagreed with a given item than did students in other groups (see Table 5 below).

#### SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

Most Fall 2010 new freshmen seem to be becoming academically and socially integrated into college life during their first a few weeks at BGSU. Although 43% of the survey respondents indicated that they missed their home and friends who are not at BGSU, the majority of them did report that it was easy for them to adjust to the University (83%), and that they got along well with others on campus (87%), made new friends easily (78%), and didn't feel lonely, left out, or isolated (79%). Two out of three pointed out that they were satisfied with their roommates as well as their living accommodations and were not bothered by the noise level on their residence hall floor. Most of them feel that the faculty and staff members they encountered at BGSU had a good attitude toward students and it's easy for them to get in touch with teachers or staff outside of class. More than seventy percent of them agreed that they can find things to do on weekends and that they liked the social life at BGSU. Eighty-four percent of the survey respondents would recommend BGSU to their friends.

Fifty-seven percent of the new freshmen found their classes challenging and yet only 22% of them have taken the advantages of mentoring or tutoring groups. One out of two claimed that they have figured out how to study effectively and were actively involved with their classes. Some of them, however, still had trouble or difficulty keeping up with their studies (19%), managing their time (19%), and deciding a major or a career (22%).

The survey results also tend to reveal some substantial differences across student groups. Caution is to be advised in interpreting the results due to the fact that, even though the distribution across groups in the questionnaire sample parallels that of the whole population in terms of gender, race and college, only 1646 respondents (43% of the first time, first year freshmen) provided valid PID numbers that allowed for group comparisons to be made. Feedback concerning how this and other studies and how they can continue to be improved is always welcome.
