other mixed choral ensemble, teaching undergraduate and graduate conducting courses, recruitment of undergraduate and graduate students, contributing to the artistic and intellectual environment of the college and university and maintaining a current profile as a choral conductor and music educator in state, regional and national activities. Depending upon the needs of the college and qualifications of the successful candidate, the chair and/or dean may assign other

duties.

- 1. Earned Doctorate or Master's degree with five years teaching and conducting experience
- 2. Teaching experience at the collegiate level preferred
- 3. Experience in working with men's voices preferred
