Instructor of Music Industry, Full-time, Non-tenure-track, 1-Year Renewable

Primary Responsibilities

The College of Musical Arts seeks an innovative and experienced music professional to teach music industry courses, supervise music industry interns, and work with the department to promote its new minor. We seek a collaborative and energetic colleague with a national or international record of music industry involvement, to teach courses in artist management and promotion, law and ethics, publishing, and music entrepreneurship. Other responsibilities may include recruiting students, developing community partnerships, and enhancing internship offerings. Additional duties may be assigned by the department chair and/or dean.

Salary is dependent upon the candidate's experience and credentials.

Minimum Qualifications

1. Master's degree in either Music, Music Business/Music Industry, Business; or Juris Doctor degree; and two years of documented work experience in the music industry in such areas as artist management, production, promotion, music publishing, copyright law, entrepreneurship.
2. Higher Education teaching experience in Music Industry courses is required.
