

Academic Program:

“The Summer Study Abroad in Japan” offers students an opportunity to study the Japanese language and to acquire the first-hand knowledge of the Japanese people and culture.

Sponsoring Schools:

Nagoya Gakuin University: NGU is located in Nagoya City, central area of Japan.

Hiroshima Jogakuin University: HJU is located in Hiroshima, western area of Japan.

Course Descriptions:

The students will attend Japanese language classes and culture classes, such as Japanese Art-pottery & wood block printing, Intercultural Communication, traditional sport-Sumo, marshal arts, Japanese cooking, flower arrangement-Ikebana, etc.

A variety of field trips, excursions, and home-stays are planned throughout the program. The students will visit the shrines, temples, the museums, castles, Kyoto, Nara, Hiroshima, World Heritage sights such as Shirakawa-Go, etc.



Date:

Leave Bowling Green on June 12, 2012 and be back on July 12, 2012.

Living Arrangements:

The students will stay one week with host families. The lodging for the remainder of the stay will be hotels and dormitories.



Eligibility:

The program is open to the students of Bowling Green State University who have completed at least one year of the elementary level Japanese language class or demonstrate its equivalent Japanese proficiency.

Credits and Cost:

The students will pay 6 credit course tuition to BGSU and receive 3 credits for the language and 3 credits for culture. (JAPN 2000 or JAPN 3000)

Application:
