

The Foundation application is used by Student Financial Aid (SFA) to identify qualified applicants for the scholarships listed below. To be considered for any of these scholarships, submit a completed application to SFA by **April 30, 2008**. Selected recipients will be notified by mail June 30, 2008. Due to the volume of applications received, only students who are selected for an award will be notified by mail.

Each applicant will be considered only for scholarships for which the criteria are met. To receive consideration for scholarships that require demonstrated need, a 2008-09 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be on file with SFA by the April 30, 2008 application deadline.

Scholarships offered through the Foundation application are highly competitive. Historically, approximately 10% of students that apply through this process will receive an award based upon a donor's specific scholarship qualifications.
