OHECC Conference Fact Sheet

Bowling Green State University, Office of the Chief Information Officer, is hosting the annual OHECC conference from April 18-20, 2007. This event brings together more than 200 professionals from Ohio's premier higher education institutions. Attendees include IT professionals from academic and administrative computing, networking, and voice, video, and data services. Attendance also includes more than 50 CIO's, directors, and high-level managers.

The conference is still evolving; however, we believe there are opportunities for all sponsors. Our April 19 breakout sessions will include an ERP Panel Discussion as well as topics on Web-casting and the Interactive Media Lab, Lights out operations, and an overview of Course Management Systems just to name a few. The April 20 Roundtables will include CIO's, Academic Courseware, Networking, Client Services, Application Programming, and software licensing issues, Technology in Education, Security, Facilities Management, Web and Lab Support.

The conference begins Wednesday, April 18, with a luncheon followed by afternoon workshops, and concludes on Friday, April 20. Conference sponsors are welcome to attend all three days. The Bowen-Thompson Student Union on the Bowling Green State University campus will be the host site for all OHECC meetings. OHECC Vendor Display Area
