Portal Overview

- What is a portal?
 - Gather a variety of useful information resources into a single, “one-stop” Web page
 - Allow customization and personalization
 - Designed to make users Web experience more efficient and institution as a whole more productive and responsive
 - Communication tool
- Goals
 - Provide a flexible, robust environment for accessing BGSU information including: teaching and learning, business applications, communication in a single, customizable environment
 - Establish a single sign-on for access to all BGSU information via the Web
 - Create a standard for information display via the Web
 - Extend and enhance BGSU’s work in integrated marketing through careful attention to messages and their audiences
