Background Information:

Several changes to the Campus Solutions system for the September Go-Live were needed that required development efforts.

Information Item:

1. PeopleSoft delivers an address type of CHK (Check Address) which was left active during the HCM implementation.

Per the Master Data Management Committee CHK address type will no longer be used. When trying to remove the address type the user was unable. An SQL was developed and tested to remove the address type. The SQL will be run as part of the September Go-Live processing.

2. Currently SIS is the record of reference for new employees/student id's. During the HCM implementation a modification was made to validate an employee id during the hire process. This modification was to ensure the employee id passed validation logic similar to the logic in SIS.

The SIS employee id validation logic is no longer needed and is being removed from PeopleSoft as we are now using the delivered auto assign employee id logic.

3. PeopleSoft delivers a page to track a person's relation with the institution. They do not deliver the logic or a process to update the information as the person's relationship changed.

A mass change process was created using PeopleSoft delivered functionality to update the relations with institution information. Mass change items would need to be manually recreated in each environment without the technical teams help. The technical team exported the mass change definition where created, and has imported it into each environment as needed for testing. This mass change definition will be moved and used in production using the same definition that was tested throughout the testing cycle.
