Background Information:

The grade average and grade distribution reports produced after each grade run were not categorized as mandated reports and were originally designated as Query reports. After further evaluation, it was determined that these reports should be developed as custom CSS reports so that consistency and accuracy would be maintained for the users of the reports.

Information Item:

The grade average report breaks down the GPA average of undergraduate students by college, level, campus and gender. These reports are used by college offices and administration to track trends in GPA averages. As such these reports are a key tool to retention.

The grade distribution report is a summary by class section of the final grades reported by each instructor. This report lists the individual sections and also provides summary information for the course as a whole. This report is distributed to department chairs, college deans and University administrators. This report has been used to explore such issues as grade inflation within individual departments.

The BG@100 Team will be developing these two reports as custom reports in Campus Solutions for the June Go-Live.
