New Purchasing Card Procedures for Grants

Beginning June 30, department purchasing cards cannot be used for grants. A PI of a grant can obtain a p-card from the Business Office to facilitate purchasing from his/her grant. If a PI has multiple grants all of the grants can be tied to one p-card. The monthly statement along with original receipts for p-card purchases must be forwarded to the grants accounting office.
