New Child Poverty Rates Available on the KIDS COUNT State Level Data Online System

State-level child poverty rates are among the 11 poverty indicators and 3 employment and income indicators that have been updated on [KIDS COUNT](#). A new indicator has also been added to the poverty profile: families with related children that are below poverty level. The estimates for these indicators are based on newly released tables from the Census Bureau and feature data from the 2006 American Community Survey.
