College of Arts & Sciences Alumni Book Scholarship

(9-\$500)

Financial need must be demonstrated
Scholarship, activities in school and home communities, plans after graduation, personal reasons for wanting to be considered for the scholarship, and other awards and honors will be considered in the selection of recipients

College of Arts & Sciences Staff Book Award

(1 - \$500)

Rising junior or senior
Cumulative GPA of at least 2.8
Preference given to student with substantial improvement in GPA from freshman year
Preference given for financial need
Employed part-time on campus
Current employees or their dependents are not eligible

Cynthia Koppenhafer Bogner Scholarship Fund

(1-\$1000)

Undergraduate student with a major within the College of Arts & Sciences
Minimum GPA of 3.0
Renewable as long as current or past recipients reapply and continue to meet all criteria

Albert P. Bradie Pre-Med Scholarship

(1-variable)

Full-time undergraduate student of color (as defined by BGSU)
Pre-Med major
Sophomore with a minimum GPA of 3.0
Must demonstrate financial need (FAFSA on file with SFA)
Renewable if student continues to meet all criteria and shows satisfactory progress toward completion of a bachelor's degree.

Angela Genovese Carlin Scholarship

(1 - variable)

Pre-Law Student, preferably a woman
Full-time undergraduate student who has demonstrated academic excellence
Preference given to student with financial need

Marjorie Schreck Carlson Scholarship

(1-\$750)

Full-time FEMALE student of German, Scottish or Swedish decent
Cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
Permanent resident from Ohio
Pre-med student, not majoring in Psych or Soc
Demonstrates financial need

William P. and Elizabeth Clark Day Scholarship

Rotates between A&S and EDHD (A&S has even years)

(1 - variable)

Full-time undergraduate students majoring in journalism
Rising sophomore, junior or senior
Minimum GPA of 3.0
Financial need and service to BGSU and external communities may be considered in the selection process
Must be a member of the editorial staff of the *BG News*

Field-Starks Family Book Award

Rotates between A&S (Biology Department) and CBA (Finance Department) - (A&S has even years)

(1 - variable)

Full-time undergraduate students majoring in biology
Financial need must be demonstrated
Minimum GPA of 3.0
Award is to be used for the purchase of books

Greene Family Pre-Med Scholarship

(1-variable)

Second semester Junior Class Ranking
Must have a GPA of 3.5 or above
Enrolled in a recognized Pre-med program at BGSU

Gordon and Laurie Bracht Hamm Scholarship*(1-variable)*

Rising sophomore, junior or senior
 Minimum GPA of 3.0
 Demonstrate high financial need
 Renewable, (up to 3 awards) as long as recipient submits another request and continues to meet all criteria

George S. John Memorial Scholarship*(1-variable)*

Full-time student of at least sophomore standing with preference given to chemistry, physics and mathematics majors
 Academic achievement shall be the prime qualification with at least an overall GPA of 3.0 and 3.5 in declared major

Rosemary Kovacs*(1-\$500)*

Full-time undergraduate student majoring in Journalism and on the staff at the *BG News*
 Preference given to past recipients (student can receive no more than four times)
 Minimum GPA of 3.0

Charles and Helen Kurfess Award *(Rotates between A&S and EDHD - A&S has even year)**(1-variable)*

Full-time undergraduate student majoring in pre-law
 Rising sophomore, junior or senior
 Minimum GPA of 2.7
 Financial need and service to BGSU and external communities will be considered in the selection process
 Preference given to student from Wood County if equally qualified candidates apply

Kurtz-Wright Scholarship*(1-variable)*

Sophomore, Junior or Senior who has attained a 3.5 GPA or higher majoring in mathematics or computer science
 Demonstrate financial need, as determined by SFA
 Renewable as long as recipient re-applies and continues to meet criteria

Levy Family Scholarship*(1-variable)*

Rising Junior or Senior A&S student planning a career in business
 Must demonstrate academic excellence
 Must participate in extra-curricular activities strengthening the University or community during their college experience

Clifford and Lynn Long Scholarship Fund*(1-variable)*

Financial need will be a consideration but not the final criterion (determined by FASFA form on file) and preference will be given to applicants that are PELL eligible based on their Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)
 Must be a U.S. Citizen, undergraduate student, and either entering or rising with his/her class
 Cannot be under athletic scholarship
 Preference given to students that are enrolled in the College of Arts & Sciences or in the College of Education and Human Development with an elementary/secondary education
 Preference given to residents of northwest Ohio (the counties of Williams, Defiance, Henry, Putnam, Hancock, Wood, Wyandot, Seneca, Sandusky, Ottawa, Fulton, Paulding, Lucas) immediately prior to BGSU entrance
 Preference given to students actively involved in outside activities either on campus or the larger community

Mecca Management/A.A. Green Realty Arts and Science Scholarship*(variable number & amount(s))*

Student must be enrolled full time in the College of Arts & Sciences
 Minimum GPA of 3.0 if entering from high school or be in good academic standing if a current BGSU student
 Recipients shall demonstrate high school/university and community leadership and be of high moral character
 Recipients shall be graduates from Bowling Green High School in Wood County, Ohio
 Preference given to students who have graduated from Wood County Ohio High Schools if no candidate fulfills all of the above criteria
 Renewable as long as current or past recipients reapply and continue to meet all criteria

John H. Moore Memorial Scholarship*(1-variable)*

Must demonstrate financial need
 Renewable as long as student reapplies
 Social Science majors only w/ at least average grades

G. O. Herbert Moorehead, Jr. Scholarship (*Rotates between A&S and CBA - A&S has even years*)**(1-variable)**

Full-time undergraduate student majoring in coursework in the College of Arts & Sciences
 Rising junior or senior
 Minimum GPA of 3.0
 Leadership skills on the BGSU campus and/or in the external community will be evaluated
 Preference given to members of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity if equally qualified candidates apply

B.F. Nordmann Scholarship Award***(1-variable)**

Rising senior
 Cumulative GPA at least 3.76
 Awarded to student who has exemplified the highest personal qualities of intellectual & cultural endeavor & attainment
 Evidence of positive aims, methodical and orderly working habits and common sense
 An academic program that has characteristically included studies stressing ideas and philosophy
***Must submit an essay presenting your viewpoints on the debate that contrasts a sound, general liberal education background against a more job-oriented or vocational skills background in today's educational preparation for work**

Dr. Marjorie Conrad Peatee Pre-Medicine Scholarship***(1-variable)**

Preference given to rising junior or senior pre-medicine majors
 Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.4
 Financial need will be considered in the selection of the recipient
***Must submit 500-1000 word essay describing your career aspirations**
 Renewable as long as recipient reapplies and continues to meet all criteria

Reyman Memorial Scholarship**(1-variable)**

Pre-med students majoring in either biology or chemistry
 Minimum GPA of 3.0
 Must be applying to or accepted by a medical or osteopathy school
 Financial need will be considered if more than one qualified applicant of similar merit

Rudolph/Libbe Arts & Sciences Dean's Scholarship***(1-variable)**

Rising senior
 Cumulative GPA at least 3.5
 Contributions to department/college/university
***Must submit 500-800 word essay addressing ONE of the following topics:**
 • whether and how a liberal arts graduate (a liberally educated person) can find success in today's modern global technological society
 • whether and why (or why not) the pursuit of knowledge for its own sake is a worthwhile goal

Matthew Albert Schaller Memorial Scholarship* (see separate information sheet for more information on this scholarship)**(1-\$500)**

***Must submit a written essay regarding a sonnet, poem, or other work from one of the following authors: Lord Byron, John Keats, or Percy Bysshe Shelley**

Raymond J. Sell Biology Scholarship**(1-variable)**

Full-time, undergraduate student in the College of Arts & Sciences majoring in biology
 Rising sophomore, junior or senior
 Minimum GPA of 2.2
 Preference given to students who demonstrate financial need, as verified by SFA
 Preference given to student from a mid-west state, but not Ohio
 Renewable as long as recipient reapplies and continues to meet all criteria

Dorothy Skriletz Book Scholarship**(1-\$350)**

Available to current sophomores or juniors in top 20% of class majoring in theatre or IPC
 Sophomore GPA at least 3.46; Junior GPA of at least 3.5

Robert G. and Carol C. Speck Scholarship in Journalism**(1-variable)**

Major in Journalism and a member of the staff of *The BG News* for one year
 Rising junior or senior
 Minimum 3.0 GPA
 If candidates are equally qualified preference given to applicant who demonstrates financial need
