

Spend Summer 2009 in Tours, France and Burkina Faso, Africa with Bowling Green State University

If you are a graduate student with a current BGSU contract as a teaching, research, or administrative assistant, you qualify for a unique opportunity to study French in Tours, France and Ouagadougou, Burkina Faso. BGSU will cover:

- Instructional and General fees for two months of study
- Housing while in France at the Technopole residence hall (host family housing is available for an additional fee)
- A partial waiver (\$600) for Room and Board in Burkina Faso (a limited number of waivers are available)
- Airfare from Paris to Ouagadougou (only if you participate in both the June session in Tours and the 4-week session in Burkina Faso)

You will be responsible for the following costs:

- Miscellaneous fees (i.e.-\$25.00 application fee, \$175.00 administrative fee, \$50.00 Education Abroad fee, and \$8.00 registration fee)
- Balance of room and board if participating in Burkina Faso module (\$600)
- Passport and visa fees
- International Student Identity Card (\$22.00)
- Airfare to and from France
- Meals while in France
- Pocket money for personal expenses
- Recommended immunizations

You may study in France for two months (tentative dates: May 29-Aug 1), or combine one month in Tours with our 4-week program in Burkina Faso (tentative dates: May 29- July 26). In Tours, classes will be held at the Institut de Touraine, a private school for non-native speakers of French. In Burkina Faso, classes are arranged by the program and are held at a variety of locations. No prior knowledge of French is required or necessary; a placement test will determine the level of coursework in which you enroll. For participation in the 2 month Tours program, you will earn letter grades for 9-12 BGSU credits; for participation in the Tours and Burkina programs, you will earn 6 credits for each program, for a total of 12 credits.

This is an excellent way to enrich your cross-cultural knowledge while learning another language, at relatively little expense to you. It is a great opportunity to enhance your resumé as well.

Please note that if you are scheduled to graduate in May 2009 but elect to study abroad in Tours/Burkina Faso during the Summer, you must apply for August 2009 graduation.
