

Study Spanish in Alcalá de Henares, Spain

with Bowling Green State University's AYA Spain Summer Program!

May 28 – July 24, 2010

If you're a graduate student with a BGSU contract as a teaching, research, or administrative assistant, you are eligible for a waiver of instructional and general fees for BGSU's two-month summer program in Spain. This is a great way to enhance your résumé and develop important intercultural skills, as well as gain proficiency in a second language.

Requirements:

- ◇ A current BGSU contract as a teaching, research or administrative assistant.
- ◇ Making satisfactory academic progress (defined as a 3.0 GPA for MA students) with no outstanding "incompletes".
- ◇ Students must attend classes in both June and July and take 9-12 credit hours.
- ◇ If you would normally graduate in May 2010, you must apply for August graduation. You may request to walk during the May ceremony but will not receive your diploma until after the August graduation.

BGSU provides:

- ◇ A waiver for instructional, general and non-resident fees (if applicable).
- ◇ A partial waiver of \$600 for room and board with a host family (a limited number of these waivers are available and they are provided only if you live with a host family for the duration of the program).

You are responsible for:

- ◇ Airfare to and from Spain.
- ◇ Room and Board fees (\$1,400.00 if you live with a host family and receive the housing waiver or \$2,000.00 if you did not receive the waiver). Note: living with a host family is not required for graduate students but the waiver is provided only to students who choose the host family option.
- ◇ Miscellaneous fees (i.e.-\$25.00 application fee*, \$175.00 administrative fee*, \$50.00 Education Abroad fee, and \$8.00 registration fee).
- ◇ Optional cultural excursion fee (\$500.00); includes hotels, meals and admission fees on all program group excursions.
- ◇ ISIC card (required for all University students studying abroad-\$22.00).

**denotes non-refundable fees. Please note that all fees are subject to change by Board of Trustees*

The deadline for applications is March 15, 2010.
