Literature Instructorship

The English Department at Bowling Green State University seeks strong applicants for an instructor position for a generalist to teach introductory literature courses with expertise in world literature and early British literature. Three-year appointment with renewal contingent upon favorable performance evaluation. May be renewed for additional three-year terms.

Duties include a 24-hour teaching load (typically four three-hour courses per semester).

Qualifications:

- 1) MA in English
- 2) Strong background in literature
- 3) Successful experience teaching undergraduate literature classes
- 4) Evidence of outstanding teaching

Salary: Competitive.

Effective Date of Employment: The starting date of employment is mid August 2008.

BGSU is a university of over 21,000 students with long traditions of teaching and scholarly excellence. It is located in a small city 25 minutes south of Toledo, Ohio, and one hour south of Ann Arbor, Michigan. The English Department offers undergraduate and graduate degrees in literature, creative writing, rhetoric and composition, and technical communication. The Department has a full-time teaching staff of 68, about 450 undergraduate majors in English, English Education and Creative Writing, and 74 graduate students.
