



## **Gwendolyn Pym Lougheed Scholarship in Canadian Studies**

### **Applicant Guidance and Application Form**

The Gwendolyn Pym Lougheed Scholarship in Canadian Studies offers financial assistance for tuition and other educational expenses to undergraduate students who are formally admitted to the Canadian Studies minor program at Bowling Green State University.

#### **Award Amount**

- Up to \$1,000.

#### **Eligibility**

- Applicant must have a record of academic excellence as demonstrated by a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all Canadian Studies courses.
- Applicant must be an undergraduate student who is currently in good standing and enrolled at BGSU during the semester for which the award is made.
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.

#### **Selection**

- Meritorious academic achievement is the primary criterion for selection, although financial need may be considered in the event of closely ranked candidates.
- The recipient will be chosen by the Director of Canadian Studies.
- Publicity generated by the Canadian Studies Center and/or the University may include the scholarship's name, amount, and purpose as well as the recipient's name and biographical information.

#### **Application Procedure**

- The application form, available in the Canadian Studies Center, must be completed and returned by March 1.
- You will receive correspondence in the mail on whether or not you are the recipient of the scholarship.
