## Admission Guidelines

Application to professional training is required and is normally submitted during the junior year. Admission is granted to applicants who have a GPA of 2.5 or higher, have completed all program course requirements with a grade of "C" or better, and are chosen for a clinical practicum position at one of the program's affiliate hospitals. Students are advised by the Medical Technology faculty.
