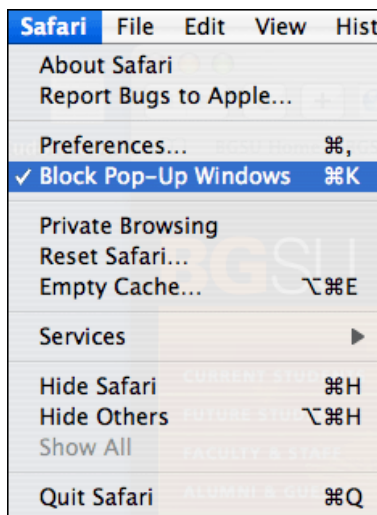


How do I enable pop-ups for CMS on Safari for the Macintosh before I start using the Rhythmyx Content Management System (CMS)?

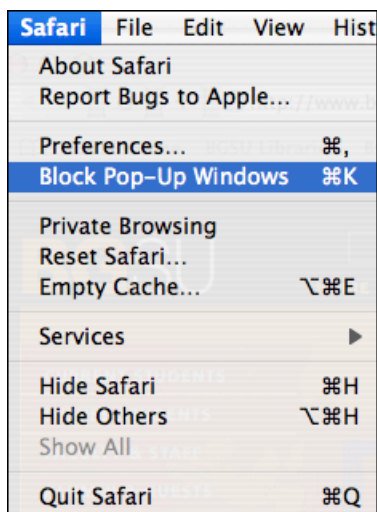
Several windows used in Content Explorer, (such as Content Editors, search windows, and Active Assembly windows) are displayed as pop-ups. If you have Safari's built in popup blocker turned on, it will prevent the display of these windows. Since Safari does not allow you to allow pop-ups just from certain sites, you will need to make sure the pop-up blocker is disabled when you are using the CMS servers.

There are two ways to disable Safari's pop-up blocker:

- On the Safari menu:



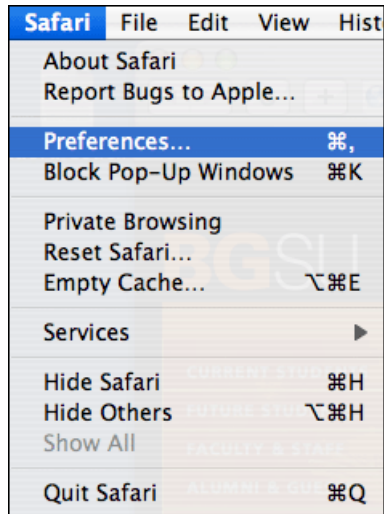
If **Block Pop-Up Windows** is checked on the Safari menu, the Pop-Up Blocker is enabled. To disable it, click on it to deselect it.



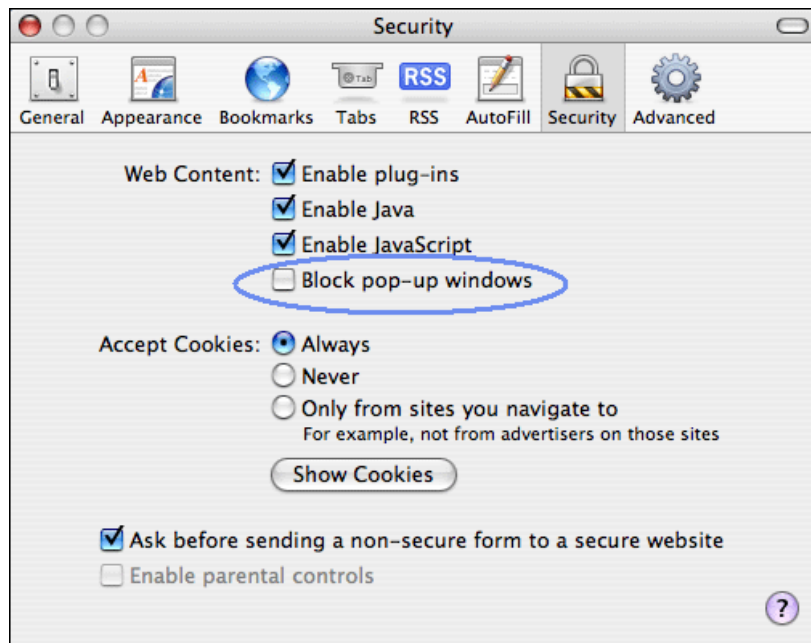
Safari's pop-up blocker is now disabled.

OR

- On the Security tab of the Preferences window:



- 1) Choose **Preferences** on the Safari menu.
- 2) Click on the **Security** tab.



- 3) Make sure **Block pop-up windows** under Web Content is unchecked.
