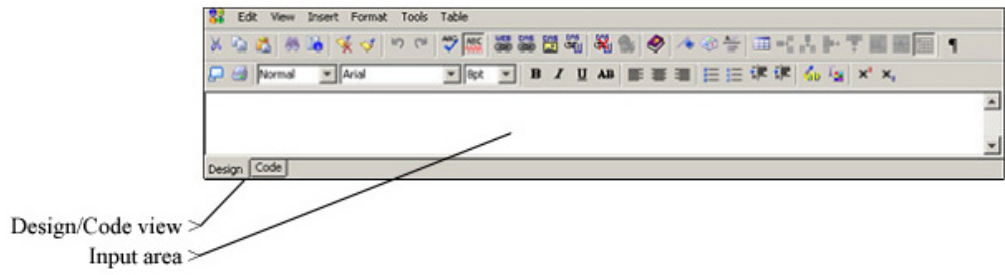
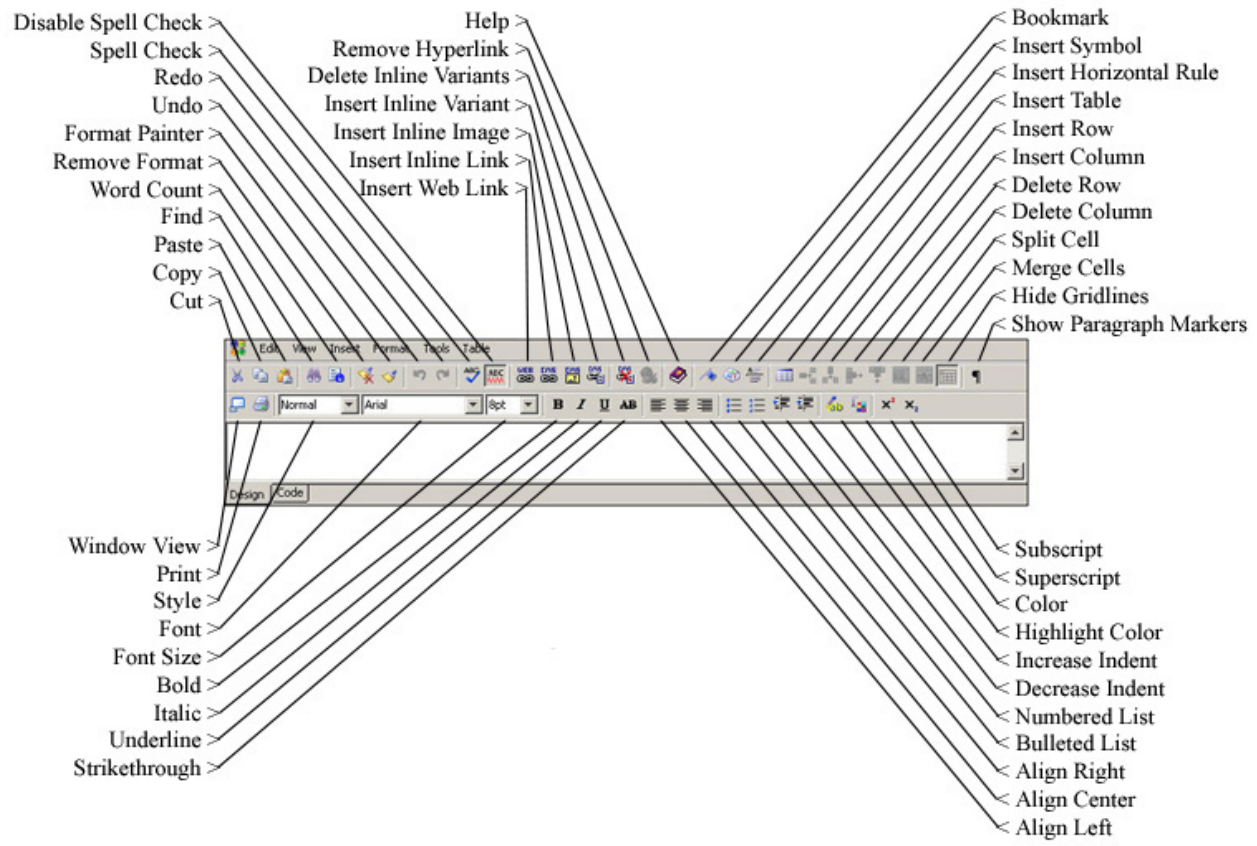
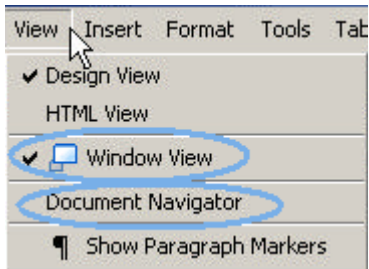


What are the features available in the Ephox rich text editor EditLive used to edit content in the Rhythmyx Content Management System (CMS), version 5.6?

**Ephox EditLive for Java Tool Bar**



- EditLive is fully keyboard accessible so clients can navigate its interface without a mouse.
- It maintains original format and layout of documents when copying and pasting from Word, Excel, or Powerpoint while removing excess HTML.
- When switching from Design view to Code view, see the code that is associated with the same line where your cursor was placed in Design view so you don't have to hunt through the code.
- Many of the functions you used to perform by right clicking on a link in 4.5 have been changed.

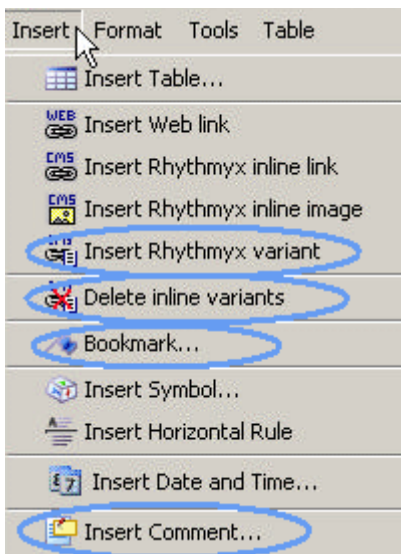
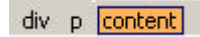


**EditLive View Menu**

- **Window View** that lets you temporarily move content created with EditLive! out of the browser into a separate window so you have more available workspace. To return to the browser, choose Browser view from the View menu, close the pop-up window or click on



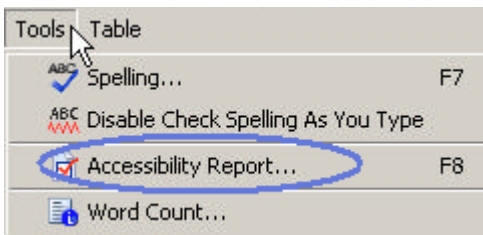
- **Document Navigator** displays XHTML tags above the body in design view that you can click on to navigate through your document.



**EditLive Insert Menu**

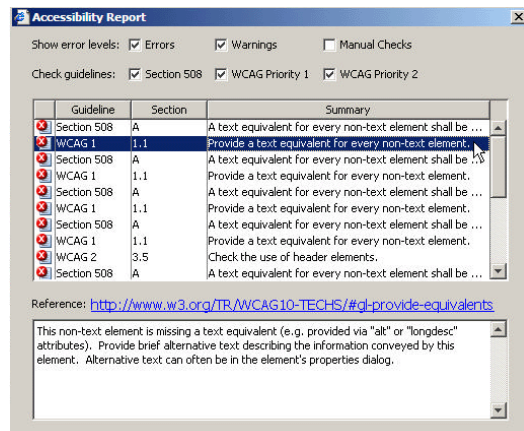
- **Insert Rhythmyx variant** allows you to insert a snippet.
- **Delete inline variants** see a list of variants (snippets) and choose which one or ones you want to delete.
- **Insert Bookmark** is used to insert an anchor tag `<a name="x"></a>` so you can later reference it as an internal link. Create the internal link by using Insert Web link and hardcoding the URL.
- **Insert Comment** will open up a special editing window that will allow you to insert the text of an XHTML comment field visible in the code view.

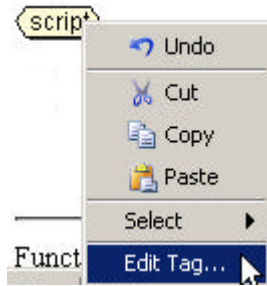
After you insert a comment, an (XHTML comment field icon) will appear in the design view.





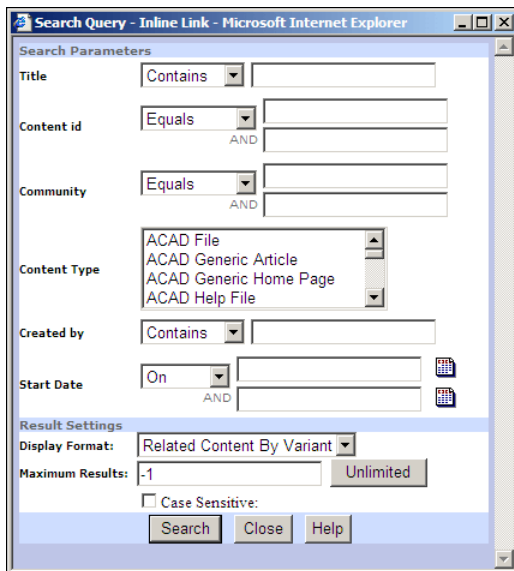
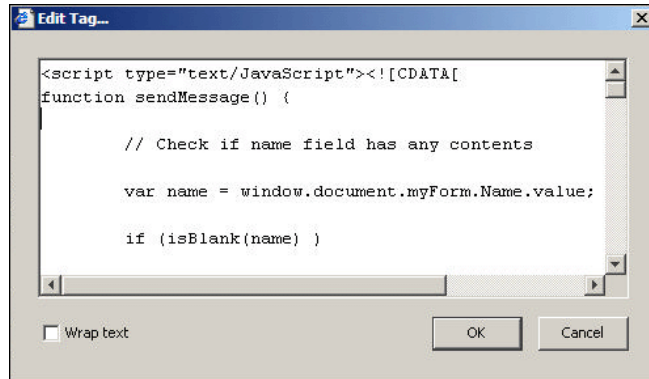
**EditLive Tools Menu**

- **Accessibility Report** so clients can check their content against the W3C's Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) and against US Section 508 regulations on software.

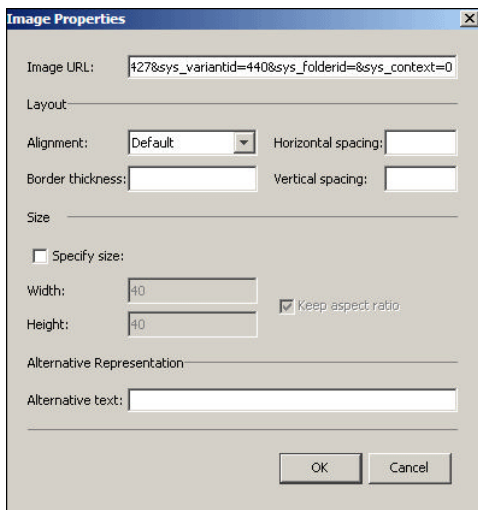




- **Edit Tag** will open up a special editing window when you double-click or right click on one of these icons:
  -  (JavaScript) and  (XHTML comment field)



- Searches in the editor are global by default (e.g. searches the content of all communities).
- *Note:* Community requires a numeric value; not a text value.
- By default, searches are not case sensitive. You can, however, select that option at the bottom of the search dialog box.
- In CMS search results, the state (e.g. Public, Draft, etc.) of content is provided in the display so you know if your link will work or image will appear when your page is published.



- Double-click on CMS image after inserting it to modify the image properties; Alternative text you enter here will appear as alt tag in the code. The Alt text you enter into the image editor still does not appear in the code.
