Position Title: Associate/Full professor (with option to come with tenure) on a nine-month appointment with the possibility of a summer contract. Tenuring academic unit will depend upon the credentials of the successful applicant.

Primary Function: Teaching, research, and service responsibilities as a faculty member as well as to coordinate and provide leadership to the Inclusive Early Childhood (IEC) Program, a dual licensure program (early childhood and early childhood intervention specialist).

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Teach undergraduate courses in the IEC Program.
2. Organize the administrative structure of the IEC program in accordance with university guidelines and within the program budget; recommend personnel as needed for the effective functioning of the program; coordinate the respective functions of all personnel working in the program.
3. Provide leadership for the IEC program.
4. Work with school directors to allocate resources to the program.
5. Communicate policies, procedures and address concerns of the IEC program with the Schools.
6. Serve as a liaison for the IEC program in relation to other schools in the College, EDHD Dean's Office and University.
7. Supervise the development and implementation of the curricula program, staffing and course scheduling – in consultation with committees, program coordinators, and school directors.
8. Serve as ex-officio member of the IEC Program Steering Committee.
9. Participate in local, state, and national early childhood/early childhood special education councils and discussions regarding services for young children.
10. Establish/maintain a productive research agenda, including grant writing activities.
11. Provide service to the university, community and profession.
12. Other duties as assigned by School Directors or Dean of the College.

Professional Qualifications:

1. Earned doctorate in a discipline represented in the IEC Program (early childhood and/or special education) or in a closely related field is required, with preference given to applicants with a doctoral degree in early childhood special education
2. A teaching license is required, with preference given to PK-3 general education or early childhood intervention specialist
3. Previous experience with IEC Programs
4. A demonstrated record of scholarly achievement
5. A demonstrated record of effective teaching
6. The ability to work collaboratively with other faculty in the delivery of instruction, program development and other responsibilities

Rank and Salary: Associate/Full Professor with an academic year contract, with the possibility of a summer contract. Salary commensurate with experience
