Superintendent

The superintendent license shall be added to a valid professional teacher license of an individual who holds a principal or administrative specialist license and shall be valid for teaching in the areas designated on the license; for supervising programs in pre-kindergarten through grade twelve; or for administrative duties in a school system.

The license shall be issued to an individual who:

- \_\_\_\_\_ has been recommended by the dean or head of teacher education at an institution approved to prepare teachers;
- \_\_\_\_\_ has successfully completed an examination prescribed by the State Board of Education; and
- \_\_\_\_\_ has evidenced the requirements specified below.
