Marilla Huber Bixler Scholarship

Annual award offered to graduate or undergraduate students pursuing a program of study in Family and Consumer Sciences. Undergraduates must have successfully completed their freshman year at Bowling Green State University and have a minimum 3.0 grade point average. Graduate students must have graduated from an approved undergraduate program in Family and Consumer Sciences with a 3.25 minimum accumulative grade point average. Selection is based on financial need, academic record, professional potential and extracurricular/service activities. The amount of the award varies.

Georgia Halstead Scholarship

Annual award offered to junior students with a 3.0 or higher grade point average in a program of study in the School of Family and Consumer Sciences. Applicants must demonstrate good character and professional promise through FCS-related extracurricular activities, volunteer work, and/or paid employment. The amount of the award varies.

Laura E. Heston Scholarship

Annual award offered to a full-time continuing undergraduate student who has achieved a 3.0 or higher grade point average and who is pursuing a program of study in the School of Family and Consumer Sciences. Preference will be given to students with financial need, and majoring in a Food and Nutrition program. The amount of the award varies.

Henrietta Robertson Matz Memorial Scholarship

Annual award offered to a full-time continuing undergraduate student who is pursuing a program of study in Family and Consumer Sciences and has a 3.0 or higher grade point average. Preference will be given to a student with financial need. The amount of the award varies.

Deanna J. Radeloff Scholarship

An annual award offered to a full-time junior or senior pursuing a major in Early Childhood Studies or Human Development and Family Studies. Applicants must be a member of Phi Upsilon Omicron Honor Society and must have demonstrated leadership and interest in Family and Consumer Sciences through FCS-related activities. The amount of the award varies.

Jean Robertson Wood Memorial Scholarship

Annual award offered to a full-time continuing undergraduate student who is pursuing a program of study in Family and Consumer Sciences and has a 3.0 or higher grade point average. Preference will be given to a student with financial need. The amount of the award varies.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INCOMING FRESHMEN

May A. Blanchard Scholarship

Annual award offered by the Toledo Chapter of Sigma Alpha Omega, for a Toledo area **incoming freshman** recommended by his or her high school principal and who is pursuing any program of study in the School of Family and Consumer Sciences. The School offers programs in: Apparel Merchandising and Product Development, Human Development and Family Studies, Dietetics, Interior Design, and Nutrition Sciences. A 3.0 or higher grade point average is required. Gail Schuler-Walter Scholarship

Annual award offered to an **incoming freshman** majoring in Apparel Merchandising and Product Development who is residing in Ohio and a graduate of an Ohio high school. A cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher is required to be considered for this award. Applicant must plan to be employed at least part-time during the academic year. Selection based on academic achievement, financial need, and professional potential.
