Personal statement which includes the following:

- Whether you are interested in the combine Master's Degree/Dietetic Internship Program or the Internship only program.
- Career goals and how the Dietetic Internship Program at Bowling Green State University can help you meet those goals
- Why you chose our program and what led you to choose a career in dietetics
- Your personal strengths and what areas you feel need development or improvement
- Identification of work or volunteer experience that exemplifies initiative and problem solving ability.
- Description of work or practicum experience that has prepared you for a supervised practice program. Make sure that you indicate the type of skills you have developed, especially if the experience was not directly related to dietetics.
