Graduate Non-Degree Student

A student who has earned a four-year degree in higher education and who wishes to enroll in graduate or undergraduate courses without pursuing another degree may enroll as a Graduate Non-Degree Student. Such a student is not limited to the number of graduate or undergraduate courses which may be taken at the University. However, for students enrolling in graduate classes, only **nine** graduate hours will transfer to a graduate degree program. There is no application fee when applying as a Graduate Non-Degree Student.

During any semester when a student is registered for a combination of main campus (including extension) and branch or resident credit center courses, fees are determined based on actual course registration. A mixture of main campus, BGSU Firelands, resident credit center and/or off-campus programs will result in a tuition calculation total based on the hourly rate schedule approved for each area by the Board of Trustees.

Formal Undergraduate/Graduate Admission to the University

Any student wishing to earn an undergraduate degree at Bowling Green State University must apply for formal admission to the University. Deadlines for submitting applications for admission to a term often occur several months before a term begins. The student should contact the undergraduate Office of Admissions, 110 McFall Center (419.372.BGSU) to obtain an application and answers to any questions about the application procedure.
