The principal license shall be added to a valid professional teacher license after successful completion of the Entry Year Program for Principals and shall be valid for working with grades four through nine for those with a middle childhood, multi-age, adolescence to young adult, intervention specialist, or vocational license.

The license shall be issued to an individual who:

- _____ holds a master's degree;
- _____ has been recommended by the dean or head of teacher education at an institution approved to prepare teachers;
- _____ has successfully completed an examination prescribed by the State Board of Education; and
- _____ has evidenced the requirements specified below.
